INTRODUCTION ABOUT THE COLLEGE

The foundation stone of Government Medical College & Hospital (GMCH), Sector 32, Chandigarh was laid by the former Prime Minister of India, Shri Chander Shekhar on 20th January, 1991. This institute is being developed as a State of the Art Medical institution and has more than 700 beds.

This institute is affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh. It was recognized by the Medical Council of India in 1998. The Institute is having an annual intake of 100 students in the MBBS Course. The First professional MBBS Course departments Viz. Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry and the Second Professional Course departments, viz Pathology, Microbiology and Pharmacology are located in Block E and the clinical department, viz. General Medicine and other specialties like Dermatology & Venereology, Psychiatry, Tuberculosis & Respiratory Diseases, Paediatrics, General Surgery and allied specialties of Orthopaedics, Ophthalmology, ENT, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Radiodiagnosis, Radiotherapy, Anesthesiology, Dentistry, Forensic Medicine and Community Medicine are functioning from Blocks A, B, C and D of the Hospital Complex. A 4 MV Linear Accelerator, MRI & CT Scan machines have been installed at GMCH, Chandigarh. The hospital has a recognized Eye Bank and a Blood Bank.

The department of psychiatry was started in February 1994 at Poly Clinic, Sector-22. The OPD services were shifted to Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH), Sector-32 in June 1995. The department got expanded after joining of Dr. B.S.Chavan as Prof & Head in 1996 and introduction of indoor facility at GMCH. The community services were added in the year 1997 and Government Institute of Mentally Retarded Children (GIMRC) now named Rehabilitation Institute for Intellectual Disability (GRIID) came under the direct supervision of the department in December, 1998. The department has 10 faculty post in Psychiatry, 3 faculty in Clinical Psychology, 2 faculty in Psychiatry Social Work and 2 faculty in Psychiatry Nursing. The department also has four posts of Senior Residents and annual intake of six (6) Post Graduate Students (MD) every year. The department also has 8 psychologists and clinical psychologists, and 11 posts of medical social workers and psychiatry social workers. The department of psychiatry provides indoor, outdoor and emergency services. The psychiatry ward is situated in 'A' Block, IV floor in hospital building. The sanctioned bed strength is 60, out of which 8 beds are earmarked for patients with substance use disorders. The psychiatry OPD is situated in B-Block, IV- Floor, OPD block. The OPD runs on all the working days. The Special Clinics include Child Guidance Clinic, Deaddiction Clinic and Sexual and Marital Clinic.

1.1 Duration : 2 years


1.2 Introduction: M. Phil. in Clinical Psychology aims at generating highly skilled and competent human resources for delivering Clinical Psychology services as well as undertaking research. The course intends to give a comprehensive coverage of (1) Psycho-diagnostic assessment; (2) Counseling and Psychotherapy; (3) Family & Marital Therapies; (4) Behavior Medicine and Cognitive Behaviour Therapy; (5) Child and Adolescent Mental Health; (6) Management of Substance Abuse; (7) Psychosocial Rehabilitation & (8) Neuropsychology. The didactic lectures, clinical teaching through case conferences and topic discussions shall be held. The seminars and Journal clubs shall provide additional input. The research orientation will be provided through the dissertation on the clinical topic. Candidate shall work under supervision, with adult and child populations with a range of psychiatric and neurological problems, thereby gaining clinical expertise.

1.3 Eligibility

1.3.1 A candidate for admission in Master of Philosophy in Clinical Psychology should have passed the Master in Psychology examination from the PanjabUniversity or any examination which has been recognized as equivalent thereto, by PanjabUniversity with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate preferably with special paper in Clinical Psychology. Candidates belonging to the reserved category SC/ST/OBC would be required to have minimum of 50% marks in aggregate.

Note: Candidates with M.A/M.Sc. degree by correspondence course or part time course or by distant education will not be eligible.

1.3.2 Candidates who have appeared in the final year examination of such Degree as defined above , shall also be eligible to appear for the Entrance Test subject to the condition that they have to submit certificate of having passed the said examination scoring not less than 55% (50% for SC/ST/OBCcategory) marks in aggregate before or at the time of interview, failing which, their candidature will stand cancelled.



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Admission

1.4.1. A candidate who wishes to be enrolled for M.Phil program shall apply to the Director Principal of Govt Medical College and Hospital (GMCH) Chandigarh on the prescribed form, by the date notified by the Institution as fixed the University.

1.4.2 The eligible candidates will be allowed to appear in entrance examination which will be conducted by GMCH, Chandigarh in accordance with the decision of the University. The paper for entrance examination will be of 100 marks and will consist of Multiple Choice type questions (MCQ's).

1.4.3 The selection of the candidates shall be made on the basis of merit in the entrance examination. To be eligible for admission, a candidate in the entrance examination, must score minimum 50% marks for a general category seat and 45% for SC category.

1.4.4 If more candidates qualify in the entrance test then the number of candidates to be called for counseling out of the qualified candidates shall be three times the number of seats. If more than one candidate get equal marks in entrance test, then the selection will be based on age criteria, who acquired the higher age will get the weightage. In case still there is a tie then total marks of MA Psychology will be considered for tie break.

1.4.5 Selection Committee consisting of Dean Medical Faculty Punjab University, Director Principal, Chairperson Department of Psychology Punjab University Chandigarh, Head of the Department of Psychiatry shall make the admissions on the basis of merit and eligibility.

1.4.6 **Leaves :** The MPhil students are entitled to avail 15 days leaves every year.

2 :M. PHIL (PSYCHIATRIC SOCIAL WORK)

Duration : 2 Years

2.1 Introduction: In two years programme, the candidates will be exposed to application of methods, techniques and skills of Social Work for promotion of mental health, prevention of mental disorders, therapeutic intervention at individual, group and family levels as well as after care and rehabilitation in institutional and semi institutional settings. In the First Year, strong grounding shall be made for advanced theoretical aspects of Psychiatric Social Work, Psychosocial Perspectives on Mental Health and Psychiatric Social work Research and Statistics The candidates shall be required to submit 5 Case Records based on their psychosocial interventions with clients and family members. Likewise in the 2nd Year, the candidates will be given a strong theoretical base with regard to social issues in mental health, Psychiatric Social Work interventions and Psychiatry, including common



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neurological problems . At the end of the 2nd Year, every candidate shall submit a Dissertation using explorative-descriptive, experimental-evaluative research studies related to Psychiatric Social Work. In all these activities the candidates will be provided adequate supervision and guidance by the faculty and staff members. A variety of participatory methods will be made use of while imparting training to the candidates in the two year programme.

2.2 Minimum educational requirement: The minimum educational requirement for the course shall be Master in Social Work from a University recognized by the UGC with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate. For SC/ST/OBC category, minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is essential. Candidates who obtained masters in social work through correspondence, part time course or by distance education will not be eligible for admission.

3. Admission

3.1. A candidate who wishes to be enrolled for M.Phil program shall apply to the Director Principal of Govt Medical College and Hospital (GMCH) Chandigarh on the prescribed form, by the date notified by the Institution as fixed by the University.

2.2. The eligible candidates will be allowed to appear in entrance examination which will be conducted by GMCH, Chandigarh in accordance with the decision of the University. The paper for entrance examination will be of 100 marks and will consist of Multiple Choice type questions (MCQs).

2.3 The selection of the candidates shall be made on the basis of merit in the entrance examination. To be eligible for admission, a candidate in the entrance examination, must score minimum 50% marks for a general category seat and 45% for SC category seat.

2.4 If more candidates qualify in the entrance test then the number of candidates to be called for counseling out of the qualified candidates shall be three times the number of seats. If more than one candidates get equal marks in entrance test then, selection will be based on age criteria, who acquired the higher age will get the weightage

2.5 Selection Committee consisting of Dean Medical Faculty Punjab University, Director Principal, Chairperson Department of Social work Punjab University Chandigarh , Head of the Department of Psychiatry shall make the admissions on the basis of merit and eligibility.

2.6 **Leaves :** The MPhil students are entitled to avail 15 days leaves every year.


*** Seats remaining vacant in reserve categories shall be filled from the eligible General Category candidates in accordance with prevailing rules on this subject.**

3.1 **Eligibility-** A candidate for admission in Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing (DPN) should have following qualification to join the course.

- (i) Be a Registered Nurse (Registered Nurse & Registered Midwife) or equivalent possessing a minimum of one year experience as staff nurse.
- (ii) Nurses from other countries must obtain an equivalent certificate from INC before admission

3.2 Admission-

3.2.1. A candidate who wishes to be enrolled for DPN program shall apply to the Director Principal of Govt. Medical College and Hospital (GMCH) by the date notified by the Institution/ University, on the prescribed form.



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3.2.2- The eligible candidates will be allowed to appear in entrance examination which will be conducted by GMCH. The paper for entrance examination will be of 100 marks and will consist of MCQ type question. However, in case the total no. of applications received for admission are less than the no. of seats available, there will not be any written test and the candidate can be admitted on the basis of their merit list in last qualifying exam.

3.2.3- In view of the less number of candidates opting for the course, the in-service candidates working in the health sector of the state govt./central govt./autonomous institutions can also apply for the course. The application should be routed through respective Director Health Services of the State.

3.2.4- The selection will be made on the basis of merit in the entrance examination which will be conducted by GMCH. The minimum cut off marks for admission to Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing course for various categories will be as follows:

- a. 50% for candidates belonging to General Category
- c. 45% for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste category

3.2.5- Merit list of entrance examination will be displayed same day by 5 pm and the candidates will be called for interview the next day.

3.2.6- Counseling Committee will consist of the following:

- 1. Principal, Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh.
- 2. Principal, College of Nursing, GMCH, Chandigarh.
- 3. HOD, Psychiatry Dept., GMCH-32, Chandigarh
- 4. Representative Faculty Member of Diploma in Psychiatry Nursing (DPN) College, Chandigarh.
- 5. Representative of the University and SC (to be nominated by the Director-Principal)

3.3.. Duration of the course

3.3.1-The minimum duration of the course shall be one academic year. It is a full time clinical training course during which the candidate will get opportunities for appropriate practicum and apprenticeship experiences.

3.3.2-A candidate admitted for DPN course shall pursue courses of study and research in the Department of Psychiatry, GMCH-32, Chandigarh.

3.3.3- Stipend: Candidates admitted to Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing Course will be paid Rs. 2000/- per month during the period of the course with the exception of the candidates who are on sponsorship/drawing pay and allowances from their employers vide order No. GMCH-TA-III(M.Phil)-2017/14216-21 dated 11.4.17.

3.3.-**Fee** : A candidate for the DPN course shall pay a tuition fee and other charges for one academic year as prescribed by the institution from time to time. The fee and other charges shall be paid before joining the course.

3.4.- Candidate will pay the examination fee to GMCH and concerned official from academic branch will deposit examination fee to Panjab University two months before the final exams.

3.5.**Attendance:** Attendance of not less than 75% of the theoretical instruction hours in each subject during one year and not less than 75% of the clinical practical hours shall be necessary for taking the respective examination along with the fee as prescribed by the GMCH/PU from time to time. Student should make up 100% of attendance for integrated practice experience and internship in terms of hours and activities before awarding the certificate.

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SCHEDULE OF ANNUAL FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

Payment of fees must be made in cash/demand draft drawn in favour of Director Principal, GMCH – 32, Chandigarh with the Cashier by the selected candidates or their representatives on the spot. If the full college fee is not submitted by the prescribed date and time, the offer shall lapse and the seat shall be offered to the next candidate in merit. The fee is liable to be increased without prior notice at the discretion of the Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh.

Candidates admitted to the M.Phil Courses (Clinical Psychology, Psychiatric social work) will be paid a stipend of Rs.12000/- per month during the course period. 


COLLEGE RULES FOR THE STUDENTS

All the students shall comply with the College rules and regulations.

1. Regular and punctual attendance in all class activities like lectures, demonstrations, practical, clinical, tutorials and tests as well as in all College activities like clinical meetings, clinic-pathological conferences, guest lectures, seminars, sports and cultural activities is compulsory. **Each student must maintain the minimum percentage of attendance required in all the class and College activities.** Students, whose conduct and academic standards are found unsatisfactory, shall not be allowed to take the University Examinations. Any student remaining absent without intimation shall be fined @ Rs.100/- per day.
2. Attendance at the College tests and marks obtained in these examinations shall be taken into consideration while making the internal assessment.
3. Leave of absence from the classes must be taken from the Heads of Departments.
4. Students returning late from leave are required to make up the time missed during summer/winter vacations with the permission of the Director Principal.



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5. In case of illness, a medical certificate by a qualified doctor must be sent immediately.
6. Students are not allowed to paste notices within the institution without prior permission from the office of the Director Principal and are also forbidden to communicate with any outside authority directly. All such communications must be submitted through the Director Principal who will forward these if considered desirable. Any student infringing this rule may be suspended.
7. The College does not hold itself responsible for debts incurred by the students in any way.
8. Students are not allowed to use Director Principal's office verandas and other places around the departments.
9. Students must pay for all damages caused by them to books and other College property.
10. Availability of hostel facility cannot be ensured.
11. College fees must be paid in full by due date. Any student whose fees, together with the fine imposed, found unpaid will be suspended from attending lectures, practicals, clinicals, etc. until the fees/dues is paid.
12. All irregularities, neglect of duties, breach of rules and indiscipline are to be brought to the notice of the Director Principal, who in consultation with the requisite enacted committee of senior faculty members shall deal with any serious offence, for which an adverse entry in personal files/student record register will be made. The penalty may either be a written or verbal warning, fine, suspension and/or removal as an office bearer of any organization and/or removal/expulsion from the college. The Director Principal is competent to remit the fine imposed by him.
13. The decision of the College Administration in all disputes would be final and binding on the student

The following are **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN** within any part of the Institution.

- (i) Possession or use of alcoholic beverages
- (ii) Possession or use of addictive or hallucinogenic drugs
- (iii) Smoking
- (iv) Gambling
- (v) Possession or use of firearms or any lethal weapons
- (vi) Loitering around, especially under the influence of alcohol

RAGGING:

- a. as envisaged by the Apex Court implies "Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear,



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apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.”

(b) '**LIABILITY**' – Ragging of students is banned by Supreme Court and GMCH is seriously concerned to carry out the same. Any activity involving ragging (participation or abetment) shall be punishable. The punishment shall be as deemed fit by the authorities under circumstances of a particular case, which may be pecuniary/ suspension from attending classes/ rustication or expulsion from College.

(c) An entry will be made in 'Character Certificate' in respect of every student regarding punishment, if any, meted out during his tenure for indulging in ragging.

(d) All the students are required to submit the undertaking as per the provisions of anti ragging verdict by the Hon'ble Supreme Court (specimen of the undertaking is available at **Appendix - II (Page No.10)**).

Leaving of course in-between/without completion by the student :

The candidate joining the course will be asked to submit an undertaking on a stamp paper stating that they will not leave the course in between and in case they do so, they will be required to repay the total amount of stipend already paid to them. Further, the selected candidate will be required to furnish a bank guarantee of Rs. 1.0 lacs in favour of the Director Principal. In the event of leaving of course in-between/without completion by the student, the amount of bank guarantee will stand forfeited. The surety will be returned after successful completion of the course.



 5. I understand that the full fee to be paid by me on being admitted to the course is as per the Prospectus, that fee is payable either by cash or bank demand draft in the name of "Director Principal, Government Medical College, Chandigarh" and that personal cheque will not be accepted.
 6. I agree to pay all dues regularly as notified by the college from time to time and on dates fixed for the purpose and understand that fees/ dues once paid are not refundable. I agree that any outstanding dues against me when I leave the college, shall be adjusted by the authorities concerned from my security deposit. I understand that after the final selection is made, the list of selected candidates, along with the waiting list candidates will be displayed on the notice board of the Government Medical College, Chandigarh and that no other notification of such results will be issued. I understand that the successful candidate wishing to claim the offered seat must deposit the first full installment of the fees on the same day after the selection, otherwise the offer will be withdrawn and the seat will be offered to the next candidate in the waiting list in order of merit.



paid as stipend to the candidate together with further sum of Rs 1.0 lacs drawn as penalty during
the course.

3. The candidate selected for the course will be required to submit a bank guarantee of Rs. 1.0
lacs immediately, definitely before the start of the session.

4. Whereas the stipendiary is nominated to the GMCH stipend at the rate of Rs.12,000/- per

agreed to do.

5. Now the condition of the above written obligation is that in the event of the above bounden

is required to do so within a period of six months after qualifying for full registration completing
the course or for other reasons not considered valid and satisfactory by the Director, Government
Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh, whose decision in this behalf shall be final, the
stipendiary and the sureties jointly and severally pay and refund to the Director, GMCH, on
demand and without demur all the amount spent on the stipendiary together with further sum not
exceeding Rs 1.0 lacs thereof as penalty on account of the said training of studies as the Director,
GMCH may direct. The decision of the Director, GMCH as to the commission of breach or any
indiscipline, misconduct on the part of the stipendiary as also the amount of penalty payable and
as to whether the stipendiary has or has not performed and observed the conditions and
obligations under these presents shall be final and binding on the stipendiary and the sureties.

6. The stipendiary except as provided in the agreement, discontinues the course to which he/she
has been admitted without completing in the middle shall be liable to pay a sum of six full
months stipend to the Institute as penalty besides forfeiture of emoluments for the month in
which he/she discontinues the course with interest until realisation and the sureties are equally
responsible.

7. And upon making such payment, the above written obligation shall be void and of no effect,
but otherwise, it shall be and remain in full force and virtue.

8. And the sureties hereby covenant with the Director, GMCH that liability of the sureties
hereunder shall not be impaired or discharged by reason of time being granted or any
