1. **ESSENTIAL EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE ETC.**

Senior Resident	(i) A basic University or equivalent qualification included in any one of the Schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956) and must be registered in a State Medical Register or Indian Medical Register; (ii) MD (PMR)/DPMR or equivalent in Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation (PMR) from government recognized institute.
4.	Physiotherapist	B.Sc. (Physiotherapy) from a recognised institution. OR Three years Diploma in Physiotherapy with 2 years experience as Physiotherapist in an institute.

2. **TENURE OF THE POST**

The above posts are temporary in nature and will be filled up by engaging a person, on contract basis only, initially for a period of one year or till the services are required, whichever is earlier. It is also made clear that it is an engagement for a fixed term and shall automatically cease on the expiry of the term without providing any claim to a person so engaged to any regularization of service or any consequential benefits.

3. **UPPER AGE LIMIT AS ON 01.01.2010:**

The upper age limit for the above said posts is as under: -

4. **RESERVATION AND RELAXATION:**

- The reservation and relaxation in the upper age limit will be made only for the category of the posts reserved for such categories, as per the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time.
- The SC/OBC candidates applying for un-reserved posts are not entitled to any relaxation in upper age limit.
- The claim of the candidate to OBC categories should be considered only when the same is accompanied by the certificate issued by the competent authority in the format prescribed by the Government of India and should have the clause of non-creamy layer.

6. **OTHER GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

- The above vacancies/categories indicative above are only tentative and are liable to change as per requirement.
- Those candidates, who are employed in Central Government/State Government/UTs/Statutory Bodies/Research Institutes etc., should send their application alongwith Service/No Objection Certificate from the employer **Through Proper Channel**.
