**Promotion/Deputation (Including short-term Contract)**

I. Officers of the Central/State Governments/Union Territories/ Statutory Bodies/Autonomous Organizations/Research Institutions :  
(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis; or  
(ii) with two year's regular service in posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 16400—20000 or equivalent; and  
(b) possessing the educational and other qualifications prescribed for direct recruits under column (8).

II. The Departmental Officer in the grade of Reader (Paediatrics) with two year's regular service in the grade will also be considered alongwith outsiders. and in case he/she is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

The Departmental Officer in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

[Period of deputation/ contract including period of Deputation/Contract in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government, shall ordinarily not exceed five year's.
