As you are aware Department of Expenditure vide O.M. F.No. 19024/1/2009-E.IV dated 13.07.2009 has stipulated travel by Air India in cases of air travel both domestic and international, where the Government of India bears the cost of air passage. It is also mentioned that in all cases of deviation because of operational or other reasons or on account of non-availability, individual cases may be referred to the Ministry of Civil Aviation for relaxation.

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2. In this regard, I wish to bring to your notice that Ministry of Civil Aviation has strived to ensure that requests received seeking permission for relaxation are processed in a time bound manner. To avoid unnecessary delays, the Ministry have now introduced the following measures:

- (a) This Ministry has identified sectors where at present Air India does not provide services and has accorded general/blanket relaxation to travel by airlines other than Air India for official purposes/LTC or TA on these Sectors. Accordingly, Ministry of Civil Aviation vide OMs dated 27.09.2013 and 27.02.2014 have identified a total of 63 such sectors (copies enclosed).
- (b) Detailed guidelines for travel by private airlines other than Air India have been put on the Ministry of Civil Aviation website www.civilaviation.gov.in

Specific format for application has been devised, which is also available in the website.

It has been decided that all such requests be sent by a-mail to <u>permissioncell.moca@nic.in</u> and the response of the MoCA shall also be sent through E-mail.
