I am directed to state that the Commission has recently observed that certain advertisements highlighting welfare schemes and achievements of the Central Government and State Governments are being published by some non-poll going State Governments, in the editions of newspapers in the States where elections are going on. The Commission considers this to be a violation of the spirit of the Model Code of Conduct.

The Commission has therefore directed that instructions contained in its letter No.437/6/CG/2013-CC&BE dated 9th October, 2013 (copy enclosed) shall be strictly followed/applied to all such advertisements, issued by non-poll going State Governments during the Model Code of Conduct period.
