Dear Secretary,

Based on the Writ Petition (Civil) No.13 of 2003 and No.194 of 2004 filed by Common Cause and Centre for Public Interest Litigation, respectively, Hon'ble Supreme Court had appointed a three member Committee headed by Prof (Dr) N. Madhava Menon to suggest guidelines for Government funded advertisements. Hon'ble Supreme Court has now delivered its judgement on the above matter on 13.5.2015. A copy of the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court is <u>enclosed</u>.

2. Hon'ble Supreme Court has observed that only the photograph of the President, Prime Minister and <u>Chief Justice of the country should be displayed in Government advertisements</u>. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has, inter-alia, also directed that "Advertisements issued to commemorate the anniversaries of acknowledged personalities like the father of the nation would of course carry the photograph of the departed leader".

3. The judgement is binding on the Union of India, State Governments and Union Territory Administrations and its agencies. This implies that the judgement is applicable to all local bodies, public sector undertakings and other autonomous bodies/organisations established under a Statute. These guidelines are applicable to all Government advertisements other than classifieds and in all mediums of communications, such as print, electronic, outdoor and digital, including internet advertising.

4. In view of above, I shall be grateful if you could kindly issue suitable instructions in your Ministry / Department, including all organisations / PSUs, concerned to take note of all aspects of judgement and comply it in letter and spirit.
