Dear Shri Bhanu Pratap Sharma,

As you are aware, as part of the first anniversary celebrations of the launch of Swachh Bharat Mission, the Ministry of Urban Development has started an intensive national sanitation drive across the country. A key feature of this sanitation drive is a series of theme-based cleanliness drives across various sectors to be undertaken in a phased manner, in order to reenergise and reinforce the nation's commitment to Swachh Bharat Mission. This was also discussed and decided in a meeting held by the Hon'ble Minister for Urban Development on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2015. The minutes of the meeting were shared vide this Ministry's O.M of even number dated 6<sup>th</sup> October 2015.

We look forward to your help and support in making this Mission and the thematic drive a success. Please keep us apprised of action taken.
