Reg: Formulation of Litigation Policy by the States of Punjab, Haryana and Union Territory, Chandigarh.

Draft litigation policy was produced on behalf of State of Haryana.

Draft litigation policies of State of Punjab and Union Territory, Chandigarh, are already available on record. State Governments of Punjab, Haryana and Union Territory, Chandigarh are again requested to exchange their draft policies and formulate a uniform draft litigation policy at the earliest after a joint meeting.

The Officers attending the meeting were apprised of the concern that on account of non-decision of the representations or legal notices, number of writ petitions are filed only seeking a direction for their disposal and then for non-compliance of the directions, within the time granted, contempt petitions are filed. Effective steps be taken to avoid this type of litigation.

They were requested to sort out the old admitted cases pertaining to different departments which may have either become infructuous or covered by any judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court or this Court and apprise the Registry through Advocate General for listing of those cases on priority. They were also requested to direct all the departments concerned to get the password issued for taking access to E-diary programme developed by the High Court.
