**Parameters for evaluation of states on Startup India programme for Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Public Administration**

Evaluation of states on the initiatives taken to create conducive environment for Startups will bring to the fore status of the progress made by them in this regard. It is likely to help the states learn from one another, foster sense of competitiveness and propel the states to work proactively towards facilitation of growth and spread of Startup movement.

The parameters that would be considered for evaluation of the States for the Award are:

Area	Parameter	Details
Startup Policy	Notifying a Startup policy	Notification of a Startup policy focussing on boosting innovation, entrepreneurship and creating new jobs and at what stage of implementation are they in.
Simplification and Handholding	Ease of registration as a Startup	States should ensure that the process of registration of a Startup as a firm is simplified and they have a single window clearance for registration of startups
	Ease of recognition as a Startup	States should devise an online system for recognition of startups by the Government and provide incentives such as tax breaks, access to funding, mentorship
	Ease of compliances under various laws	Startups recognised by the government should be given exemption from compliances under various laws, such as, labour laws, tax laws, environments laws, etc. This may also include self-certification and inspection free regime
	Facilitation for setting up of incubators	States must ensure that it encourages more and more incubators to be set up and it is well spread in tier 2 and tier 3 cities
	Dedicated Startup Cell/ Helpline	A dedicated Startup cell or hub should act as a one-stop-shop for all the queries that startups may have regarding processes. It should also help them in developing their ideas, products, incubation, pitching for funds and go-to market strategy
	Dedicated Startup Portal/ Mobile App	These should act as a platform for easy accessibility and information dissemination for Startups, incubators, investors and also help them interact with each other. They should also host all online learning and development modules that could help Startups in setting up or running their venture.
Funding support	Initiatives to increase access to funds for Startups and formulating a credit guarantee scheme	Dedicated funds should be set up to fund innovative Startups. Besides, to catalyse availability of credit to innovators, states have to set up Credit Guarantee Fund for Startups.
Industry-	Partnerships with	States should partner with companies to

Academia partnership	Industry and Educational Institutes to set up incubators and support for vocational training institutes	help set up incubators under Corporate Social Responsibility. Industry should also be encouraged to support vocational training institutes which in turn can help hone the entrepreneurial skills of the candidates and help them start their own ventures.
Fest/Events	Organizing Startup Fests/ Events	<p>The States should also conduct at least one festival or event focussed on startups, which could act as a meeting ground between:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Investors and Startups - Startups can pitch for funds and investors can also choose the Startups they want to invest in</li> <li>- Industry and Startups - Industry can also come and choose a product that can help them in their business through the product pitches that Startups make and Startups will get direct market linkage</li> <li>- Besides, these events can also have a competition organised for Startups to look for innovative solutions to problems that the government, industry and common citizens are facing.</li> <li>- Collaboration with international Startup festivals should be done to gather knowledge on best practices and learn from their success stories.</li> </ul>

Dear Chief Secretary / Administrator

As you are aware, following programmes have been identified for presentation of awards to best districts/ implementing units under the "Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration" –

(i) Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (ii) Deendayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojna  
(iii) Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (iv) Start Up India/Stand Up India (v) e-National Agriculture Market (National e-Mandi).

2. In addition, two Awards will be given for Innovations in the field of environment conservation, disaster management, water conservation, energy, education and health, women and child centric initiatives etc. The Organizations of Central/ State Governments, Districts are eligible for PM's Award for Innovations. Submission of application for both kinds of Awards will start from 01.01.2017.

3. Hon'ble Prime Minister during his speech on last Civil Services Day held on 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2016, desired that a healthy competition of good governance, best practices, accountability and responsibility should be developed amongst districts across the country in true spirit of cooperative federalism. It will be for welfare of citizen and overall development of the country, if each and every district participate for identified priority programme in the spirit of competition under PM Award Scheme.

4. Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) has developed a web portal for online registration of Districts / Mandis(e-NAM) /States for choosing programme to compete for PM Awards. The States/UTs have to register on portal to choose "Start Up India" and for remaining programmes District / Mandi need to get registered and choose programmes. In this regard my earlier letter dated 24.08.2016 may please be referred. We have shared login Id and password of PM Award portal with you on your mail-id to facilitate monitoring of progress of registration and choosing programme by the Districts/Mandis(e-NAM). The current status of registration and choosing priority programme by the Districts / Mandis(e-NAM) of your State is enclosed.

5. The Department has engaged M/s KPMG Advisory Services Ltd. as consultant to assist in the selection process of PM Awards and to serve as Knowledge partner in organisation of Civil Services Day 2017. The personnel of KPMG will approach the concerned authorities of your State/ UT for hand holding support in this regard.

6. You would appreciate that wider participation for PM Awards, would help in expediting implementation of identified programmes which in turn will benefit the common citizen. I would be grateful, if you could adopt the following approach and issue necessary directions to the District authorities to generate healthy competition for PM Awards

- (a) Maximize the participation by districts under the Prime Ministers Awards scheme through registration and choosing the programmes. The date for registration and choosing the programme is extended up-to 30/11
- (b) Focus on implementation of the schemes in all the Districts/ States/ UTs etc.
- (c) From 01<sup>st</sup> Jan. 2017 maximize submission of the applications by the Districts/ implementing units/ States.
