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

As you are aware, following programmes have been identified for presentation of awards to best districts/ implementing units under the "Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration" –

(i) Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (ii) Deendayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojna
(iii) Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (iv) Start Up India/Stand Up India (v) e-National Agriculture Market (National e-Mandi).

2. In addition, two Awards will be given for Innovations in the field of environment conservation, disaster management, water conservation, energy, education and health, women and child centric initiatives etc. The Organizations of Central/ State Governments, Districts are eligible for PM's Award for Innovations. Submission of application for both kinds of Awards will start from 01.01.2017.

3. Hon'ble Prime Minister during his speech on last Civil Services Day held on 21st April, 2016, desired that a healthy competition of good governance, best practices, accountability and responsibility should be developed amongst districts across the country in true spirit of cooperative federalism. It will be for welfare of citizen and overall development of the country, if each and every district participate for identified priority programme in the spirit of competition under PM Award Scheme.

4. Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) has developed a web portal for online registration of Districts / Mandis(e-NAM) /States for choosing programme to compete for PM Awards. The States/UTs have to register on portal to choose "Start Up India" and for remaining programmes District / Mandi need to get registered and choose programmes. In this regard my earlier letter dated 24.08.2016 may please be referred. We have shared login Id and password of PM Award portal with you on your mail-id to facilitate monitoring of progress of registration and choosing programme by the Districts/Mandis(e-NAM). The current status of registration and choosing priority programme by the Districts / Mandis(e-NAM) of your State is enclosed.



6. You would appreciate that wider participation for PM Awards, would help in expediting implementation of identified programmes which in turn will benefit the common citizen. I would be grateful, if you could adopt the following approach and issue necessary directions to the District authorities to generate healthy competition for PM Awards:

- (a) Maximize the participation by districts under the Prime Ministers Awards scheme through registration and choosing the programmes. The date for registration and choosing the programme is extended up-to 30/11.
- (b) Focus on implementation of the schemes in all the Districts/ States/ UTs etc.
- (c) From 01st Jan, 2017 maximize submission of the applications by the Districts/ implementing units/ States.



2. The process of registration of Districts / Mandis/ States for choosing the priority programme is in progress on PM Awards portal. As a part of registration, States/UTs may choose "Start up India". District / Mandis may chose "e-National Agriculture Market" and Districts may choose one or more of the remaining priority programmes for competing in PM Awards.

3. In addition to Awards in Priority Programme, Awards will also be given for Innovations in the field of environment conservation, disaster management, water conservation, energy, education and health, women and child centric initiatives etc. Apart from Organisations of Central / State Governments, District organisations are eligible for PM's Award for Innovations.

4. The pdf format of Application forms for the Prime Minister's Awards have been uploaded on PM Awards Portal (link is available on our website www.darpg.gov.in). **Online Submission of Application for PM Awards for excellence in implementation of Priority Programme and Innovations shall start from 01.01.2017 on Prime Minister Award portal. Last date of submission of application is 14.01.2017.**

5. More than 600 districts have chosen the Priority Programmes for participation under the Prime Minister's Awards Scheme. Other districts can still register and choose the programme. It is expected that all such registrations will result into applications from 1st to 14th January. Districts and other organisation of State are also eligible for Awards in the 'Innovation' category. I shall be grateful, if you issue necessary instructions to Districts and other organisations of State to maximize the participation for the Prime Ministers Awards by applying on the portal for both Priority Programme and Innovations from 01.01.2017.
