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As per the provisions of the Indian Medical Council (Amendment) Act 2012, the Government will soon have to reconstitute the Medical Council of India by conducting elections. The constitution of the Council is provided under Section 3 of the IMC Act and clause (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 3 provides for electing a member for the Council from amongst the Registered Medical Graduates of the State.

I shall be grateful, if you kindly direct the Director (Medical Education) of your State to initiate the process of election under clause (c) of sub-section (1) of section 3 of the IMC Act from amongst the Registered Medical Graduates of your State. While initiating the election process, the DME would need to ensure that the names of persons, registered in the State Medical Council, have also been entered in the Indian Medical Register maintained by MCI and that there are no duplication or multiple registrations in various states.

I am enclosing a format in which the information of the members elected under Section 3(1)(c) of the IMC Act is required to be furnished to the Ministry.
