The Ministry of External Affairs attests original documents/true copies of documents for use abroad.

2. At present, all original documents/copies requiring attestation or apostille are first authenticated by the designated authorities of the State/UT from where the document has been issued. In case of personal documents, Home/General Administration Department of the concerned State Government/UT are the designated authorities. In case of educational documents, the same have to be first authenticated by the Education Department of the concerned State/UT. Commercial documents are to be pre-authenticated by the respective Chambers of Commerce. As a step towards de-centralization in first phase, eSanad has already started in five (5) Passport Offices viz., Chandigarh, Goa, Thiruvananthapuram, Mumbai and Bengaluru, and is presently in the process of being implemented in the Attestation Cell of the Ministry.

3. In order to make attestation service easier, less time consuming and reducing the overall cost to the applicant, MEA is working on eSanad, with National Informatics Centre (NIC), as technology and rollout partner. The following are the key points of eSanad:

- i. eSanad is aimed at online verification of the documents with an objective to extend contactless, cashless and paperless service to applicants for attestation/apostille of documents, in India as well as abroad.
- ii. eSanad facilitates making of the application as well as the payment online through Non Tax Receipt Portal (NTRP, bharatkosh.gov.in), making the service contactless and cashless.
- iii. An e-Register has already been introduced for foreign employers/Embassies to check the veracity of the attestation.
- iv. eSanad has already been integrated with CBSE's Academic Repository 'Parinam Manjusha' which has the digitized data for Class 10 Class 12 from 2014 onwards, on May 24, 2017.

4 In the next phase of eSanad, e-Apostille will be issued, making the service completely paperless. (Till the time e-Apostille is not issued, the printed apostille will continue to be issued.)

5. In order to broaden the usage of eSanad, the Ministry would like to work with the State Government. For this, the technical details of the integration process need to be worked out between the IT team of the State with the NIC.
