- (c) The round will take place as per roster given below. During the round following aspects will be discussed: antimicrobial treatment of indoor patients whose culture is positive, need of deviation from the stated antibiotic policy of the department/unit, difficult cases who do not respond to antimicrobial treatment, random checking of records that the antimicrobials being prescribed are in right dose, right route and by right method of administration.
- (d) The round will take place once a week during afternoon (any time suitable to the departments between 2 and 5 PM)

 - b. Departments of Microbiology and Pharmacology should assign consultants for the rounds and make a roster. Consultants assigned to a particular department should remain with the department for at least 3 months to ensure continuity.
 - c. The round will take place as per roster given below.
