The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's OM of even no. dated 31.01.2013 (copy enclosed) where the decision of the then President on the above mentioned subject was communicated to all the Ministries/Departments, Chief Secretaries of all the State Governments and Union Territories, etc., for implementation. The President's Secretariat has again reminded in the matter. It has been desired/advised to discontinue the use of words 'His Excellency' and its Hindi equivalent 'महामहिम' and instead use of words "राष्ट्रपति महोदय" during ceremonial occasions and "राष्ट्रपतिजी" in official notings in Hindi.

Subject: -Discontinuation of the salutation of "His Excellency" while addressing the President of India.

The undersigned is directed to communicate that after due consideration, the President has approved the discontinuation of the salutation of "His Excellency" while organising functions within the country and during interaction between Indian dignitaries and the President. This salutation will, however, continue in interaction with foreign dignitaries. It has also been desired by the President that during the ceremonial occasions where currently the salutation 'His Excellency' or the Hindi equivalent 'महामहिम' is used, the future practice would be to use the word "Hon'ble President" or the Hindi equivalent 'राष्ट्रपति महोदय'.

2. It is, therefore, requested that appropriate action may be taken for implementation of the above decision of the President.
