As a befitting tribute to the Father of Nation on 2nd October, 2018, the Government of India has taken the ambitious pledge to achieve cleanliness with 100% scientific disposal of solid waste through best solid waste management practices under the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM).

The Govt. of India has notified Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 vide notification dated 08.04.2016. Wherein it is the duty of the waste generator to segregate and store the waste in three separate streams namely bio-degradable, non-biodegradable and domestic hazardous waste.

The bio-degradable, non-biodegradable and domestic hazardous waste consists following waste:-

Bio Degradable (wet waste)	Non-Biodegradable (Dry waste)	Domestic hazardous waste
Vegetables waste	Plastic/Metal	CFL Bulbs, tube-lights
Food waste	Coconut shell	Paint drums
Garden waste	Thermacol	Pesticide cans
Wood pieces	Foam	Expired medicines
Hair/nails	Rexene	Broken mercury thermometer
Egg shells	Paper, Tetra packs, rinsed out milk packets, plastic food containers, worn out shoes	Used needle, syringe and contaminated gauge.
Bones	Cloth	Used batteries
Flesh	Rubber	CD, Floppy
Used cotton	Used Sanitary Napkins, diapers duly wrapped.
