As you are aware, Department of Personnel and Training (DOPT) in government of India is committed to create an enabling environment for development and management of human resources of the Government for efficient, effective, responsive, transparent and ethical Governance. To this end, this department implements the scheme of Domestic Funding of Foreign Training (DFFT) with an objectives of knowledge and skill development of our officers through cross country exposure to developments in Public Policy and international best practices.

2. This Department is of the view that there is a need for comprehensive approach in training in areas which involve more than one ministry of the government and where there is considerable gap in the domestic academic sector. In this approach, people working in related areas are sent for training together so that they return and work in sync with each other on a comprehensive issue where inputs from all the areas are important for an effective implementation. It has also been noted that the practitioners knowledge available within the government system is usually not matched with adequate academic inputs to generate a holistic policy responses for cotemporary problems in government with the result that the Governments are often constrained to approach consulting firms. This new approach is also aimed at avoiding such recourse to consultants and may result in building up of capabilities for holistic responses within the Government itself. Groups of officers from different Ministries and Organizations will be selected as a group and undergo short term courses abroad for their knowledge up-gradation on that specific issue and at the end will provide a concrete actionable policy response to the specific contemporary challenge faced by the government. This approach has been accorded in-principle approval by the competent authority.

3. It is therefore, imperative that specific contemporary Public Policy and governance issues and challenges are identified across the Ministries/ Departments and Federal set-ups so that this Department could come up with a comprehensive policy note on the subject. I, therefore, request you to identify and communicate to us major policy challenges faced by your organizations/Government which, in your view, can be effectively sorted out through the above initiative of this Department.
