

In terms of Rule 13(2) of Delegation of Financial Power Rules, 1978, I am directed to convey the approval of the competent authority for enhancement of Delegation of Financial Powers to UT Administrations under different categories. Item-wise Financial & Administrative powers delegated to UTs are as follows:-

Administrative Power			
4	Ex-gratia/Death compensation due to accidents in course of performance of duties under Extra ordinary Pension Rules.	Cases are referred to MHA.	Powers will be exercised by UT Administration in consultation with their Finance Deptt. subject to following the extant Govt. orders on the subject.

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
* Under Delegation of financial powers upto Rs. 100 cr. to all UTs in terms of MoF OM dated 05.08.2016, it is clarified that these financial powers are related to issuing administrative approval & expenditure sanction (AA&ES) of projects (excluding PPP Projects) which have already been appraised and approved by competent authority as per the provision of DoE/MoF OM dated 05.08.2016. For appraisal and approval of PPP Projects separate orders issued by the Department of Economic Affairs will apply.

2. The above mentioned Financial & Administrative power has been delegated, subject to following conditions:-

- i. All codal formalities should be followed as per the provisions laid down in GFR, DFPR, CPWD Code/ Works manual, Economy instructions and other instructions issued by MoF, MHA & MoUD from time to time.
- ii. Budgetary provision should exist in the financial year concerned.
- iii. The financial powers including sanction of expenditure on works will be exercised in consultation with Finance Secretary/ Finance Department of UT.

3. This issues with the concurrence of IFD/ MHA vide Diary No. 3435542 dated 05.12.2018 and approval of the competent authority.

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
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
