I am directed to refer you on the subject eited above and to point out that the Full Bench of the Hon'ble Madhya Pradesh High Court vide its judgment dated 28.09.1995 rendered in the case Misc. Petition No. 2522 of 1984, titled as " 'Hanumantsing Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh" and the Division Bench of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court vide its judgment dated 25.09.1991 rendered in Criminal Writ Petition No. 406 of 1988 titled as "Govind Shanwar Chatal Vs. Dattatraya Waman Bhanushali and another, declared Section 21 of the Bonded Labour (Abolition) Act, 1976, as un-constitutional being violative of Article 21 of Constitution of India.
