Please refer to this Department's earlier Order No. F. 1/67/EC/84 dated 17th December, 1984 on the above-mentioned subject. Paragraph (4) of the Order states that unless all procedural requirements are met and proposals are submitted to the Department at least three weeks in advance it would be difficult for this Department to clear such proposals in advance.

- 2. In this connection, it has been noticed that the proposals regarding foreign visits of Ministers/Members of legislative Assemblies/ Officials of State/ UT Govts often do not contain the complete details (i.e Political Clearance, FCRA clearance etc.) and are also not submitted well in time.
- 3. It is once again reiterated that proposals for foreign visits should be submitted to the Department of Economic Affairs complete in all respects, and at least three (3) weeks in advance, so that this Department would have sufficient time to clear the proposals.
