#### ORDER

In continuation of Ministry of Home Affairs's Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) Dated 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 and in exercise of the powers, conferred under Section 10(2)(I) of the Disaster Management Act, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, National Executive Committee, hereby orders to include the following in the consolidated revised guidelines for strict implementation by Ministries/ Departments of Government of India, State/Union Territory Governments and State/ Union Territory Authorities:

- I. Sub-clause (viii) under Clause 6 'A' on All Agricultural and horticultural activities:
  - viii. Collection, harvesting and processing of Minor Forest Produce (MFP)/ Non Timber Forest Produce (NTFP) by Scheduled Tribes and other forest dwellers in forest areas.
- II. Sub-clause (iii) under Clause 6 'C' on on Plantations:
  - iii. Bamboo, Coconut, Arecanut, Cocoa, spices plantation and their harvesting, processing, packaging, sale and marketing.

# III. Sub clause (v) & (vi) under Clause 7 on Financial Sector:

- Non-Banking financial institutions (NBFCs) including Housing Finance Companies (HFCs) and Micro Finance Institutions (NBFC-MFIs) with bare minimum staff.
- vi. Cooperative Credit Societies.
- IV. Clause 16 (i) on construction activities in rural areas, includes, water supply and sanitation; laying/erection of power transmission lines and laying of telecom optical fiber and cable along with related activities.

Dear Chief Secretory

Please refer to MHA Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 15<sup>th</sup> April 2020, vide which consolidated revised guidelines on the measures to be taken by the Ministries/ Departments of the Government of India, State/UT Governments and State/UT Authorities for containment of COVID-19, has been circulated for the strict implementation in all parts of the Country.

2. I would like to draw your kind attention to clause 4 (i) and (ii) of these guidelines which, *inter alia*, mentions that (i) State/UT Governments shall not dilute these guidelines under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 in any manner and shall strictly enforce the same and (ii) State/ UT Governments, may, however, impose stricter measures than these guidelines as per requirement of the local areas.

3. Your attention is also drawn to the Order dated 31.03.2020 in the Writ Petition (Civil) No 468 of 2020, in which the Hon'ble Supreme Court is pleased to observe that (quote) "we trust and expect that all concerned viz. State Governments, **Public Authorities and Citizens of this country will faithfully comply with the directives and orders issued by the Union of India** in letter and spirit in the interest of public safety" (unquote). The observations, which must be treated as directions of the Apex Court, was conveyed in my DO letter of even no dated 1st April 2020 to all States/ UTs Governments.

4. It has come to notice that some of the States/ UTs are issuing orders allowing activities which have not been allowed as per guidelines issued by MHA under the Disaster Management Act, 2005.

5. I would again urge you to ensure compliance of the revised consolidated guidelines, and direct all concerned authorities for their strict implementation in letter and spirit without any dilution and to ensure strict compliance of lockdown measures.

# Dear Chief Securitory

Please refer to MHA Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 15<sup>th</sup> April 2020 & 16<sup>th</sup> April 2020, vide which consolidated revised guidelines on the measures to be taken by the Ministries/ Departments of the Government of India, State/UT Governments and State/UT Authorities for containment of COVID-19, has been circulated for the strict implementation in all parts of the Country.

2. Vide Order of even number dated 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2020, *clause 14(v)* of the consolidated revised guidelines, relating to E-commerce companies has been excluded. In this regard I would like to clarify that while operations of e-commerce companies for non-essential goods stands prohibited, however they will continue to operate for essential goods as has been allowed earlier and continue to be allowed under clause 13(i) of these guidelines.

3. You are therefore requested to clarify this to all the field agencies and also adequately disseminate amongst the general public so as to ensure smooth movement of the entire supply chain of essential goods, including by e-commerce. The guidelines/ Orders issued by the State Governments/ UT Administration in pursuance to MHA Orders may please be suitably modified to reflect the correct position.
