It has come to the notice of the undersigned that certain staff are demanding for station leave and also pressing hard for allowing station leave. In this regard, attention is invited to the office order dated 23.06.2020 issued from the office of Adviser to the Administrator, U.T.-cum Chairperson, State Executive Committee of State Disaster Management Authority, UT, Chandigarh vide it has been mentioned that due to increasing cases of COVID 19, it is imperative to regulate the movement of persons who are coming to U.T Chandigarh from outside the Tri-city and stay for more than three days. Therefore, to minimize the movement of our staff, following guidelines are required to be followed with immediate effect.

- 1. The station leave should ordinarily not be allowed. In exceptional circumstances, it should be permitted.
- 2. If any staff has taken station leave and remained out of station for 72 hours, on return, he or she will be self-quarantined for 14 days. In case of regular employees, the period of 14 days quarantine will be debited to leave of kind due and in case of contractual employees, the period of 14 days quarantine will be treated as without pay.
- 3. All are also abide by the other conditions of office order of Chandigarh Administration issued vide No. 13180-HIII(5)/2020/16304 dated 23.06.2020 (copy attached at flag A)
