Dear Sir,

You may kindly recall that in the month of October, 12, I have written to all the state governments commending the Integration of Medical Education with Primary and Secondary Health Care institutions.

We have outlined the following 3 aspects which characterize the functioning of CMC, Vellore, Tamil Nadu.

1. Linking Medical Colleges to the Health System to strengthen not only tertiary care but primary, secondary care at district and sub district level.
2. This linkage may facilitate the practical orientation for Medical Education even as it provides local health needs and equitable access to health care.
3. Ensuring that research becomes relevant to local health needs.

In my earlier letter, I have also offered assistance from CIPS in association with CMC, Vellore to bring resources for initial handholding for this practice.

We have since received a note from Dr. Anand Zachariah, Vice Principal, CMC, Vellore on "Project for linking Medical Colleges with the Health System" and the various actionable items relating to this practice. I enclose the same.

CIPS and CMC, Vellore would be happy to replicate this model in some select medical colleges, which are to be linked to district and sub district public health institutions.
