

**GOVERNMENT MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL, CHANDIGARH**

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA, GENERAL CONDITIONS & FEE FOR ADMISSION IN MBBS  
COURSE 2025 IN UT POOL FOR THE CANDIDATES BELONGING TO OBC (NCL)  
CATEGORY**

Candidates are advised to go through the CENTRALIZED ADMISSION PROSPECTUS, MBBS/BDS/BHMS COURSES, SESSION 2025-26 for detailed information.

**Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats reserved for OBC (NCL) category including OBC (NCL) PwD candidates: -**

1. The OBC (NCL) including OBC (NCL) PwD candidates must fulfill relevant Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats as reproduced below:

**A-3): Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats:**

In supersession of the Notification No. GMCH/TA-1(4/E)/2018/45819-27 dated 31.10.2018 and all other notifications/ instructions/ orders issued in this regard, the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is pleased to amend the eligibility criteria for admission to State (UT Chandigarh) Quota Seats in MBBS course in Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector-32, Chandigarh.

The following criteria shall be followed for admission to State (UT Chandigarh) Quota Seats in MBBS Course in GMCH-32, Chandigarh from the date of issuance of this notification vide No. 4486/E-134842/F-II(GMCH)/2023/10399 dated 15.07.2022: -

1. Candidates, who had completed 10th, 10+1 and 10+2 from schools/ colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, as regular student of the said school/ college.

OR

2. Candidates, whose parents are residents of Chandigarh for the past 05 years immediately preceding the date of application, even if they do not satisfy the criteria as laid down in condition No.1 above. The requisite residence certificate issued from the *Office of Deputy Commissioner, UT Chandigarh*, will be taken as proof for this purpose.

OR

3. Candidates, whose parents are employees of Central Government/ State Government and who are on deputation to U.T. Administration, including government employees of Chandigarh Administration/ employees working in

autonomous bodies/ companies in which Chandigarh Administration has 20% or more share, for the past 03 years immediately preceding the date of application, even if they do not satisfy the criteria as laid down in condition No. 1 & 2 above.

OR

4. Those candidates who are wards of serving Defence Personnel/ Ex- Servicemen, having permanent address of UT Chandigarh in their service record, at the time of entry into defence services. The requisite certificate for permanent address issued by the respective Competent Authority will be taken as proof for this purpose.

**One-time exemption of proviso 6 & 7 of Clause A-3 of Centralized Admission Prospectus MBBS/BDS/BHMS courses 2025 is allowed to the fresh applicants/ registrations belonging to the OBC (NCL) category.**

2. The candidate belonging to OBC (NCL) Category will be eligible for benefit of reservation of socially and educationally backward classes in UT Chandigarh, subject to the following conditions as mentioned in the letter no. 27/4/94-IH(7)-2024/2685 dated 04.09.2024 issued by the Department of Personnel, Chandigarh Administration, :  
-
  - (i) The candidate shall actually belong to the community claimed.
  - (ii) His/ Her community shall be included in the list of OBCs issued by the Central Govt. in respect of U.T. Chandigarh or his/ her community shall be included in Central list of Other Backward Classes for the Union Territory of Chandigarh, forwarded by the Social Welfare Department, U.T., Chandigarh, from time to time, by notification/ order(s).
  - (iii) The person shall belong to Union Territory, Chandigarh.

Note: The Central list of Other Backward Classes for the Union Territory of Chandigarh has been mentioned in the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' Notification S.O 3598(E) dated 05.08.2025 as forwarded by the Secretary, Social Welfare, Women & Child Development, Chandigarh Administration, vide No SWD/RA/OBC-Act/2025/6692 dated 07.08.2025.

**In addition to submission of applicable certificate to establish their eligibility for UT Chandigarh Pool, Candidates belonging to OBC (NCL) category must submit following certificates:**

- i. Certificate of belonging to Union Territory, Chandigarh issued by the Tehsildar/ Magistrate 1st Class/ Deputy Commissioner of UT Chandigarh and bearing the

seal of the issuing authority (Specimen copy of the certificate is appended as Appendix C-1).

- ii. OBC certificate containing the clause of non-creamy layer (NCL) issued by competent authority of UT Chandigarh (Specimen copy of the certificate is appended as Appendix C-1).

**Important:**

***Certificate, not bearing the seal of the competent authority, will not be accepted.***

3. A candidate must have secured the following minimum percentage of marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together in 12<sup>th</sup> standard examination:

OBC (NCL) category: (Including OBC (NCL) PwD category)	not less than 40%

4. The candidates must have come in the rank list prepared as a result of NEET (UG) - **2025** by securing following minimum marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology taken together:

OBC (NCL) category: (Including OBC (NCL) PwD category)	not less than 40th percentile

5. Candidates must have claimed his/ her eligibility for OBC (NCL)/ OBC (NCL) (PwD) category while applying for NEET (UG) - **2025** examination. NEET (UG) - **2025** result card must mention that candidate belongs to OBC (NCL) Category.
6. Fresh OBC (NCL)/ OBC (NCL) PwD applicants will be considered for admission against seats reserved for OBC (NCL)/ OBC (NCL) PwD candidates only according to their merit in the NEETUG - 2025. However, OBC (NCL)/ OBC (NCL) PwD candidates who have already applied during initial application process will be included in the combined merit list and considered for selection against unreserved seats as well as OBC (NCL)/ OBC (NCL) PwD categories according to their merit in the NEETUG - 2025.
7. PwD candidates selected against seats reserved for PwD will be compulsorily placed in the category to which they belong i.e. UR-PwD in UR, SC-PwD in SC, OBC (NCL)-PwD in OBC (NCL). Seats reserved for OBC (NCL) category include seats reserved for OBC (NCL)-PwD. Number of seats allocated to OBC (NCL)-PwD will be deducted

from total number of seats available in OBC (NCL) Category. Only remaining seats will be allocated to candidates other than OBC (NCL)-PwD candidates.

8. Any seat(s) remaining unfilled from UT Chandigarh Pool OBC (NCL) Category on account of non-availability of eligible candidates shall be added to UT Chandigarh Pool General Category and filled from combined merit list as per merit/rank in NEET (UG) - 2025.
9. All other General conditions of counseling and admission will also apply on OBC (NCL) candidates.
