- Before applying, candidates are advised to go through the admission notice published in the newspaper and instructions given in the prospectus carefully and then fill the online Application Form which will be available in two parts:

Part-I: To be filled for appearing in GCET-2026.

Part-II: To be filled by the candidates who qualify GCET-2026 for appearing in counseling for admission to various courses. It shall be mandatory to fill Part-II of the application form and upload the certificates/ documents listed for appearing in counseling.

- Prospectus is available only as PDF document on GMCH Website www.gmch.gov.in for viewing/downloading. It is not available in printed form.
- Application form is available online, only on GMCH Website. Candidate has to fill this online application form and submit it online, once completed.
- **All candidates have to submit the application fee ONLINE ONLY, at the time of filling online Part-I of application form. Fee cannot be deposited in any other form such as cheque, demand draft etc.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

According to Chandigarh Administration's circular No. 19/1/93/IH (3-99/11136) dated 9th June, 1999, distribution of seats will be as below:

1. UT Chandigarh Pool (85%):

85% seats of the total sanctioned intake of an institution will be filled up from amongst the ***students who have passed their qualifying examination from schools/colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and located in the Union Territory, Chandigarh, as regular students of the said school/college.***

In-service candidates:

Employees who are in regular employment with UT Health Department/Department of Medical Education and Research and have completed regular service of five or more years in the concerned discipline in the UT Health Department/Department of Medical Education and Research are In-service candidates.

All candidates who fulfil the above mentioned criteria for In-service candidate will be eligible to apply against seats reserved for In-service candidates in the UT Chandigarh Pool in the B.Sc. course related to the subject of their experience, according to their rank and merit in GCET 2026, irrespective of the fact whether they fulfil the criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool or not.

In addition, In-service candidates who fulfill the eligibility criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool will also be considered for admission in B.Sc. course related to the subject of their experience, only against General/SC/OBC(NCL)/PwD categories, according to their eligibility, merit and rank in GCET 2026.

In-service candidates must submit NOC from the employer at the time of submission of application only, failing which their application will be rejected.

- 2. General Pool (15%):** Remaining 15% seats will be filled from amongst ***students who have passed their qualifying examination from institutions other than those located in the Union Territory, Chandigarh.***
- 3. In both pools, 15%** seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes (SC).**
- a. To be eligible for UT Chandigarh Pool SC Category, the SC certificate must be issued from the Competent Authority of U.T. Chandigarh.**
- 4. In both pools, 5%** seats are reserved for Persons with Disability (PwD) on horizontal basis.**

- a. Horizontal reservation cuts across vertical reservation (in what is called interlocking reservation) and candidate selected against the quota for PwDs have to be placed in the appropriate category viz. SC, OBC (NCL) or General depending upon the category to which they belong. Candidates applying for admission under the quota reserved for PwD must select whether they belong to SC, OBC (NCL) or General category while filling the application form.
- b. Only those candidates who have 40% or more disability will be eligible for admission against seats reserved for PwD.
- c. Disability criteria as prescribed by NMC for admission in undergraduate medical courses would be applicable in respect of all Bachelor courses, except B.Sc. Nursing course.
- d. For B.Sc. Nursing course, INC criteria i.e. disabled candidates with a disability of loco-motor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity, will be eligible for admission against seats reserved for PwD.
- e. Candidate must have claimed his/her eligibility for PwD category while applying for GCET 2026 examination.
- f. SC (PwD) candidate will be eligible for selection against seats reserved for SC (PwD) category, OBC - NCL (PwD) candidate will be eligible for selection against seats reserved for OBC - NCL (PwD) category and General (PwD) Candidate will be eligible for selection against seats reserved for General (PwD) category. There will be no combined merit list for PwD candidates.
- g. "Own merit" General (PwD), SC (PwD) & OBC- NCL (PwD) candidates will be eligible for selection against General category seats according to their rank and merit in the combined merit list.
- h. Criteria c & d will be used to determine medical fitness of the candidates in respective courses.
- i. ***Disability Certificate issued by Government Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh only will be accepted.***

****In calculation of percentage of seats for General pool and reserved category(s) in both pools, the figure has been rounded off to lower whole number if decimal point is less than 0.50, and to higher whole number if the decimal point is 0.50 or more.**

5. In both pools, 3% seats are reserved for Other Backward Class (OBC) (NCL). As per letter No. SWD/RA/OBC-Act./2025/6692 dated 07.08.2025 issued by the Secretary Social Welfare, Women & Child Development, Chandigarh Administration Twenty-seven per cent. reservation shall be provided to Other Backward Classes in services. *Reservation in admissions – Twenty-seven per cent. reservation shall be provided to Other Backward Classes in admissions under the Union territory Pool in all the Higher Educational or Technical or Medical Institutions working under the control of Union territory Administration of Chandigarh and the Central Government Aided Institutions who are getting Grant-in-Aid from Union territory Administration of Chandigarh, which shall be implemented over a staggered period of six years, as under :-

- a. To be eligible for UT Chandigarh Pool OBC (NCL) Category, the OBC (NCL) certificate must be issued from the Competent Authority of U.T. Chandigarh.
- b. The candidate belonging to OBC (NCL) Category will be eligible for benefit of reservation of socially and educationally backward classes in UT Chandigarh, subject to the following conditions as mentioned in the letter no. 27/4/94-IH(7)-2024/2685 dated 04.09.2024 issued by the Department of Personnel, Chandigarh Administration, :-
- (i) The candidate shall actually belong to the community claimed.
 - (ii) His/ Her community shall be included in the list of OBCs issued by the Central Govt. in respect of U.T. Chandigarh or his/ her community shall be included in Central list of Other Backward Classes for the Union Territory of Chandigarh, forwarded by the Social Welfare Department, U.T., Chandigarh, from time to time, by notification/ order(s).
 - (iii) The person shall belong to Union Territory, Chandigarh.

Note: The Central list of Other Backward Classes for the Union Territory of Chandigarh has been mentioned in the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' Notification S.O 3598(E) dated 05.08.2025 as forwarded by the Secretary, Social Welfare, Women & Child Development, Chandigarh Administration, vide No SWD/RA/OBC-Act/2025/6692 dated 07.08.2025.

In addition to submission of applicable certificate to establish their eligibility for UT Chandigarh Pool, Candidates belonging to OBC (NCL) category must submit following certificates:

- i. Certificate of belonging to Union Territory, Chandigarh issued by the Tehsildar/ Magistrate 1st Class/ Deputy Commissioner of UT Chandigarh and bearing the seal of the issuing authority (Specimen copy of the certificate is appended as Appendix -VII).
- ii. OBC certificate containing the clause of non-creamy layer (NCL) issued by competent authority of UT Chandigarh (Specimen copy of the certificate is appended as Appendix VII).

Important : Certificate, not bearing the seal of the competent authority, will not be accepted.

6. All the above courses are open to Indian Nationals only.
7. Age: Minimum 17 years as on 31.12.2026.
8. Candidate should clearly specify the Pool against which he/she wishes to apply (UT Chandigarh Pool/General Pool).
9. Candidate should clearly specify the category against which he/she wishes to apply (General/SC/OBC-NCL/PwD/In-service).
10. Candidates desirous of applying for more than one course, if eligible, **are not required** to submit separate application form. The candidates can choose discipline of their preference, if available, in order of their rank in the GCET-2026 at the time of counseling.
11. Candidate appearing/appeared in the qualifying 10+2 Standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination in 2026, where the result is awaited, can also apply. However, he/she/others shall not be eligible for admission, if he/she/others doesn't pass the qualifying examination with the required pass percentage of marks prior to the first round of Counseling. He/she/others will be allowed to attend first counseling only if detailed marks certificate of the above said examination is submitted prior to or at the time of first counseling, failing which he/she/others will be declared ineligible for admission year 2026 and his/her/their application will be rejected.

12. Admission will be made strictly on the basis of rank secured in GCET-2026.
13. Candidate must have come in the merit list of GCET- 2026 by securing following minimum marks:

For Nursing course:

General/General PwD, OBC-NCL, OBC-NCL (PwD category)	: not less than 50 th percentile
SC/SC PwD category	: not less than 45 th percentile

For other courses:

General/General PwD OBC-NCL, OBC-NCL(PwD) category	: not less than 45%
SC/SC PwD category	: not less than 40%

14. Admission to these courses will be strictly on the basis of rank/merit obtained in GMCH Combined Entrance Test (GCET-2026) to be conducted by Government Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh.
15. 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) passed candidates will be eligible for all B.Sc. courses provided they choose option 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) for taking GCET at the time of filling Part-I of application. Candidate can choose discipline/course at the time of counseling on the basis of merit obtained in the Entrance Test (GCET-2026) subject to the availability of the seats in the respective course.
16. 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry, Math) passed candidates will be eligible for ONLY Bachelor of Anaesthesia and Operation Theatre Technology (BAOTT).
17. The candidates **will have to choose** whether they will apply for Aptitude for Nursing/patient care, Physics, Chemistry, **Biology** and English **OR** Aptitude for Nursing/patient care, Physics, Chemistry, **Math** and English as subjects for the entrance exam.
18. **Those candidates who opt for Aptitude for Nursing/patient care, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English** will be eligible for applying to all the following courses: B.Sc. Nursing, BMLS, BMRIT, BRTT, BAOTT & B. Optom.
19. **Those candidates who opt for Aptitude for Nursing/patient care, Physics, Chemistry, Math and English** will be eligible for applying for BAOTT **ONLY**.

“NOTE: CANDIDATES WHO HAVE PASSED 10+2 WITH BOTH MATHS AND BIOLOGY WILL HAVE TO CHOOSE EITHER MATHS OR BIOLOGY. OPTING FOR BOTH SUBJECTS FOR THE ENTRANCE EXAM SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED.”

20. Candidates who have already completed diploma course after passing 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) will also be eligible for all the Allied and Healthcare Courses **provided they choose option 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry & Biology)** for taking GCET at the time of filling Part-I of application.
21. Candidates who have already completed diploma course after passing 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) will be eligible for admission in all the Allied and Healthcare Courses related to the subject of their diploma course **only if they choose option to take GCET in the subject of their diploma course** at the time of filling Part-I of application.
22. Candidates who possess Vocational qualification will be considered for admission in all the Allied and Healthcare Courses related to the subject of their vocational course only. Such candidates should choose option to take GCET in the subject of their vocational course at the time of filling Part-I of application.
23. Candidates who have obtained Diploma course qualification after 10th standard will be considered for admission in all Allied and Healthcare Courses related to the subject of their diploma course only. Such candidates should choose option to take GCET in the subject of their diploma course at the time of filling Part-I of application.
24. A person in regular employment shall also be eligible as in-service candidate provided he/she/others possesses requisite essential qualifications and must have come in the merit list of GCET-2026 by securing minimum qualifying marks i.e., 45% for General category/ General PwD, OBC-NCL/OBC-NCL(PwD) and 40% for Scheduled castes (SC)/SC PwD, categories. He/She/Others should be in regular employment with UT Health Department/Department of Medical Education and Research and has completed service of five or more years in the concerned discipline in the UT Health Department/Department of Medical Education and Research subject to submission of NOC from the employer. These candidates will be eligible for admission in all Allied and Healthcare Courses related to the subject of their experience only. Such candidates should choose option to take GCET in the subject of their experience at the time of filling Part-I of application.
25. Seats remaining vacant in In-service category of UT Chandigarh Pool will be filled from General category candidates of UT Chandigarh Pool.
26. Seats remaining vacant in SC (PwD) category will be filled from SC category candidates, Seats remaining vacant in OBC-NCL (PwD) category will be filled

from OBC-NCL category candidates and Seats remaining vacant in Gen (PwD) category will be filled from General category candidates of respective pool.

27. Seats remaining vacant in SC, OBC (NCL) category in all the courses shall be filled from the eligible General Category candidates from the respective pool in accordance with the prevailing rules on this subject.
28. Seat(s) remaining unfilled from General Pool shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool General Category candidates.
29. **Mop-Up round:**
 - a. Any reserved category seat(s) surrendered by reserved category candidate(s) will be first offered to the candidates from the reserved category candidates of the respective Pool. If the seats still remain unfilled, these seats will be added to the General Category seats and filled from General category candidates of respective pool.
 - b. If seats still remain unfilled due to non-availability of eligible candidates in either pool, the same will be filled from Combined Merit List of other pool i.e. if seats are unfilled in General Pool these will be filled from Combined Merit List of UT Chandigarh Pool and if seats are unfilled in UT Chandigarh Pool, these will be filled from Combined Merit List of General Pool.

1. Online Application Form will be available in two parts:

Part-I: To be filled for appearing in GCET-2026

Part-II: To be filled by candidates who qualify GCET - 2026 for appearing in counseling for admission in various courses. For those candidates who have qualified the GCET-2026 entrance examination, it shall be mandatory to fill-up Part-II of application form and upload the certificates/ documents listed.

2. Candidate has to fill online application form available at GMCH website: **www.gmch.gov.in**
3. Before applying, candidates are advised to go through the admission notice and the instructions, published in the newspapers / prospectus carefully and then fill in the online application form.
4. Before applying for any course, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils all the eligibility norms. The candidate should have the requisite educational qualifications from recognized University/Institute. GMCH, Chandigarh can reject the application of candidate at any stage of admission process, in case the candidate is not fulfilling the requisite criteria.
5. 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) passed candidate will be eligible for all B.Sc. courses. Candidate can choose discipline/course at the time of counseling on the basis of merit obtained in the Entrance Test (GCET-2026) subject to the availability of the seats in the respective course. He/She/Others should choose option "10+2 (Physics, Chemistry & Biology)" as a subject for taking GCET at the time of filling Part-I of application.
6. Candidate who has already completed diploma course after passing 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) will also be eligible for all B.Sc. courses provided he/she/others chooses option "10+2 (Physics, Chemistry & Biology)" as a subject for taking GCET at the time of filling Part-I of application.
7. Candidate who has already completed diploma course after passing 10+2 (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) will be eligible for admission in the B.Sc. course related to the subject of his/her diploma course only if he/she/others choose option to take GCET in the subject of his/her diploma course at the time of filling Part-I of application.

8. Candidate who possesses Vocational qualification will be considered for admission in the B.Sc. course related to the subject of his/her vocational course only. He/She/Others should choose option to take GCET related to subject of his/her vocational qualification at the time of filling Part-I of application.
9. Candidate who has obtained Diploma course qualification after 10th standard will be considered for admission in the B.Sc. course related to the subject of his/her diploma course only. 10. A person in regular employment with UT Health Department/Department of Medical Education and Research and has completed service of Five (05) or more years in the concerned discipline in the UT Health Department/Department of Medical Education and Research shall be eligible as in-service candidate. He/She/Others will be eligible for admission in the B.Sc. course related to the subject of their experience only. He/She/Others should choose option to take GCET in the subject of his/her experience at the time of filling Part-I of application.

14. **No candidate will be allowed to appear in the counseling without producing all applicable original documents/certificates. Attested copies/Digi-Locker copies/any other virtual copies/letter of possession of original documents and certificates by any other Institution will not be entertained for granting admission to a candidate.**

16. Candidates after scrutiny of original documents will be escorted to the venue of the counseling.
17. Sequence of counseling will be for General Category seats first, followed by Reserved Category seats.
18. All qualified candidates and “own merit” SC category candidates will be considered for admission against General category seats in their respective pool according to their rank/merit in the combined list, in addition to the SC category they have applied for.
19. SC (PwD) candidates will be considered for admission against seats reserved for SC (PwD) only. In addition, “own merit” SC (PwD) candidates will be considered for admission against General category seats according to their merit rank in combined merit list.
20. OBC-NCL (PwD) candidates will be considered for admission against seats reserved for OBC-NCL (PwD) only. In addition, “own merit” OBC-NCL (PwD) candidates will be considered for admission against General category seats according to their merit rank in combined merit list.

21. General (PwD) candidates will be considered for admission against seats reserved for General (PwD) only. In addition, "own merit" General (PwD) candidates will be considered for admission against General category seats according to their merit rank in combined merit list.
22. In-service candidates who fulfill the eligibility criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool "*Students who have passed their qualifying examination from schools/colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and located in the Union Territory, Chandigarh, as regular students of the said school/college*" will be considered for admission against seats allocated to UT Chandigarh Pool in the General category in addition to the reserved category to which they belong i.e. In-service, SC or PwD category according to their rank and merit in GCET 2026 in the subject of their experience. OBC (NCL) or PwD category according to their rank and merit in GCET 2026 in the subject of their experience. However In-service candidates who don't fulfill the eligibility criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool will be considered only against the seats reserved for In-service candidates in the subject of their experience.
23. Candidates belonging to SC/PwD/In-service category, who obtain admission in the General category on the basis of their rank/merit in the Entrance Test (GCET-2026), shall not be counted towards the seats earmarked for the concerned reserved category.
24. Candidates belonging to SC/PwD category, who obtain admission in the General category on the basis of their rank/merit in the Entrance Test (GCET-2026), shall continue to get all the benefits available to the concerned reserved category candidates.
25. Candidates belonging to OBC (NCL)/PwD/In-service category, who obtain admission in the General category on the basis of their rank/merit in the Entrance Test (GCET-2026), shall not be counted towards the seats earmarked for the concerned reserved category.
26. Candidates belonging to OBC(NCL)/PwD category, who obtain admission in the General category on the basis of their rank/merit in the Entrance Test (GCET-2026), shall continue to get all the benefits available to the concerned reserved category candidates.
27. If a qualified candidate reports late for counseling when his/her/others turn according to his/her/others rank/merit has already been passed over,

he/she/others will be considered as per available seats/stream/discipline/ course at the time of his/her actual reporting in the counseling.

28. Second counseling/ Subsequent counseling will be conducted for the vacant seats, if any available. Information to this effect will be displayed on the website of Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh i.e. www.gmch.gov.in.
29. Candidate who didn't appear in the first counseling is allowed to appear in the second counseling and subsequent counseling provided he/she/others is qualified and has filled Part-II of application form. He/She/Others will be offered the available seat as per his/her/others rank/merit.
30. Candidate once admitted cannot participate in counseling again except in case where he/she/others wants to change discipline/course of admission. He/She/Other has to surrender the seat in writing one day prior to the day of subsequent counseling.
31. Seats remaining vacant in SC (PwD) category will be filled from SC category candidates and seats remaining vacant in Gen (PwD) category will be filled from General category candidates of respective pool.
32. In case of non-availability of qualified SC category candidates or any other reserved category candidates in UT Pool/General Pool, these seats will be filled from qualified General Category candidates from respective pool in the second round of counseling.
33. Seats remaining vacant in OBC (NCL) (PwD) category will be filled from OBC (NCL) category candidates and seats remaining vacant in Gen (PwD) category will be filled from General category candidates of respective pool.
34. In case of non-availability of qualified OBC (NCL) category candidates or any other reserved category candidates in UT Pool/General Pool, these seats will be filled from qualified General Category candidates from respective pool in the second round of counseling.
35. Seat(s) remaining unfilled from General Pool shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool General Category candidates at the time of second counseling.

36. Mop-Up round:

- a. Any reserved category seat(s) surrendered by reserved category candidate(s) will be first offered to the candidates from the reserved category of the respective Pool. If remain unfilled, these seats will be added to the General Category seats and filled from General category candidates of respective pool.
- b. If seats still remain unfilled due to non-availability of eligible candidates in either pool, the same will be filled from Combined Merit List of other pool i.e. if seats are unfilled in General Pool these will be filled from Combined Merit List of UT Chandigarh Pool and if seats are unfilled in UT Chandigarh Pool, these will be filled from Combined Merit List of General Pool.

ADMISSION

1. Selected candidates will have to undergo medical examination by the constituted Medical Board on the same day or succeeding day of counseling. Candidates found medically fit shall be granted admission.
2. Candidates who do not appear before the Medical Board or are found medically unfit shall not be allowed to join the course.
3. Fees are to be paid on the day of medical examination after candidate is found medically fit. The candidature of the eligible candidates, who do not deposit the prescribed fees in full, shall stand automatically cancelled and vacancies so caused shall be offered to the candidates in the subsequent counseling. No correspondence or appeal in this connection will be entertained by the Admission Committee.
4. Admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with the rules/criteria mentioned in this Prospectus. However, in all matters which need interpretation or for which no provision exists in the Prospectus, the decision of the Admission Committee shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained regarding rejection or disqualification of any candidate.
5. Original certificates of the selected candidates will be retained by the college. The original certificates of the selected candidates shall be returned only if the seat is surrendered in writing by the candidate.
6. In case the information furnished or certificates/documents submitted by the candidate are found to be fake or is found to have withheld or concealed information in the application form, his/her admission shall stand cancelled and the fee deposited shall be forfeited. In addition, he/she/others may also face legal action.
7. All admissions shall be provisional and subject to the approval of the concerned regulatory bodies.
8. All legal disputes relating to admission of students will be subject to the courts having jurisdiction in Chandigarh.
9. Any directions/order governing admissions to the course from the Government/Hon'ble courts/Regulatory bodies will be binding on all candidates.

The above fee structure is subject to revision by Panjab University authorities and same shall be applicable accordingly.

2. Annual fee can be deposited through debit card/credit card/UPI etc. with PLA Cashier, Academic Branch or online through GMCH website **www.gmch.gov.in**.
3. In case of surrender of seat, the fees and other funds deposited at the time of admission will be refunded after deduction of Rs. 1000/- of total amount paid at the time of admission if seat so vacated gets filled up. If the seat so vacated is not filled up, the entire fee & funds deposited at the time of admission shall stand forfeited and only the security fee will be refunded after the written request by the student.
4. If a candidate surrenders B.Sc. seat at any stage after completion of admission process including during the duration of the course, the fee for the whole remaining course will be charged from the candidate as penalty.

OTHER INFORMATION

1. Medium of teaching/instructions will be English
2. **Hostel:** No hostel facility will be provided to any student and they have to make their own arrangements for Boarding/lodging.
3. **Stipend:** No stipend will be given to any student during the course of any stream except B.Sc. Nursing where stipend will be paid during internship only.
4. **Library:** There is a well-stocked library with all essential professional books, journals and magazine etc.
5. **Students' Health:** The services of Government Medical College & Hospital will be available to the students during the time of illness free of cost but there is no facility of reimbursement.
6. **Counseling and Guidance:** Students' personal problems will be looked into and necessary counseling and guidance will be given by the teachers. The students are free to approach faculty members for the purpose.
7. **Sports and Recreation:** Facilities are available on as well as off the campus.
