1. Prospectus is available only as PDF document on GMCH Website www.gmch.gov.in for viewing/downloading. It is not available in printed form.
2. Application form is available online only at GMCH Website i.e. www.gmch.gov.in. Candidate has to fill this online application form and submit it online, once completed. It is not available in printed form.
3. **Application fee must be paid online only. It cannot be paid in the form of cheque, demand draft, cash or any other physical means.**
4. All candidates have to fill the application form online, available at GMCH Website www.gmch.gov.in. **Candidate has to fill a single form for MBBS, BDS and BHMS courses and select multiple courses within the same form. Additional application fee is payable for each course selected and is to be added, as courses are selected, while filling the online application form. *Candidate will have to pay the total fee online, in a single transaction.*** Only those candidates who successfully submit the online application form, along with specified annexures and fees by the due date, will be included in the list of candidates eligible to appear for counselling, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility criteria, as specified in the prospectus.
5. **Candidate must bring separate set of printouts, along with necessary annexures for each course, at the time of counselling, he/ she has applied for. *Printout for each course for which candidate has applied, can be obtained by selecting the course in PRINT APPLICATION page of online submitted application form after logging in.***
6. **Candidate must bring original certificates/ documents at the time of Counselling. No digital document or Digi-locker certificates will be accepted.**

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING

1. Prospectus is only available as PDF document on GMCH Website www.gmch.gov.in for viewing/downloading w.e.f. **08.08.2026 (Saturday)**. It is not available in printed form.
2. Application form is available online only, at GMCH Website w.e.f. **08.08.2026 (Saturday)**. It is not available in printed form.
3. Before applying, candidates are advised to go through the admission notice published in the newspapers and instructions given in the prospectus carefully and then fill in the online Application Form.
4. All candidates have to fill application form online, available at GMCH Website www.gmch.gov.in. **Candidate has to fill single form ONLY for MBBS, BDS and BHMS and may select multiple courses in the options.**
5. **Additional application fee is payable for each course selected and added while filling the online application form. Candidate has to pay the total fee online in a single transaction.**
6. The candidates should fill all the relevant fields in the form. No field/Column should be left blank.
7. Category of reservation should be entered in the prescribed column of the online application form. No addition or change of category of reservation will be allowed once form has been submitted.
8. Candidates applying for MBBS/BDS/BHMS courses should upload following applicable documents at the time of filling up the application form online: -

Procedure for filling application form online and Deposit of Fee online: -

Flowchart of steps for filling the application form online.

All steps are mandatory to complete the application process.

Step 2	Go to “Admission”
Step 3	Register by clicking on “Candidate Registration”. Candidate will receive a confirmation on email including his/her Application ID on registered email address.
Step 4	Login by clicking on “Candidate login”.
Step 5	Candidate will have to fill demographic details and save the same
Step 6	Candidate will have to fill Educational Qualification demographic details and save the same
Step 7	Candidate will have to select course and category and save the same
Step 8	Candidate will have to Upload Photo & Signature in JPG format (<50KB)
Step 9	Candidate will have to upload certificates/ documents as mentioned in the form/ prospectus
Step 10	Candidate should check the detailed information filled in the previous steps through review filled form before final submission

COUNSELLING

Important:

- i) **The candidates should bring with them all the requisite original Certificates/ documents for verification at the time of counselling.**
 - ii) **Attested copies of the certificates or similar other documents will not be entertained for granting admission to a candidate to the MBBS/BDS/BHMS course.**
1. List of provisionally eligible candidates, according to their rank/merit in NEET (UG) - **2026** and category, will be displayed on the Website of Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh.
 2. **Final eligibility for admission against various categories will be determined after scrutiny of original documents at the time of counselling.**
 3. All eligible candidates including OCI card holder (as per point no.5 of eligibility criteria at Page no..18 and General conditions at Point no.2 at Page No.19) and "Own Merit Candidates"* from reserved categories (SC/PwBD, OBC (NCL)/PwBD), will be considered for admission against General Category seats according to their rank/merit in the combined list, in addition to the category/categories they have applied for.

* A candidate belonging to specified category who is selected on the same standard as applied to General Category candidates and who appears in the General Merit list is treated as Own Merit Candidates.
 4. Candidate(s) belonging to a reserved category who fulfill all the criteria for general category (own merit candidates) and on the basis of his/her rank/merit in the NEET (UG) – **2026**, obtains admission in general category, shall not be counted towards the seats earmarked for the reserved category concerned.
 5. It is further clarified that SC/ PwBD, OBC (NCL) PwBD) candidate who obtains admission in the general category on the basis of his/her rank/merit will continue to get all the benefits such as fee concession etc., if available to such candidates admitted against seats reserved for Scheduled Castes/ PwBD, OBC (NCL) PwBD).
 6. **Personal appearance** of candidate before the Counselling/ Admission Committee is **mandatory** for claiming seat as per rank/merit determined and displayed.
 7. Mere attending the counselling for a course does not confer any right to admission in that course. Admission will be strictly according to the rank/merit in NEET (UG) – **2026**.

8. ***Counselling shall be conducted in the following order: PwBD Category, followed by General, OBC(NCL), and SC Category Seats.***
9. If any eligible candidate reports late for counselling after his/her turn, as per rank/merit, has already passed, he/she shall be considered only against the seats available at the time of his/her actual reporting and shall have no claim over seats already allotted during the counselling.
10. A candidate once granted admission, cannot re-appear in subsequent counselling for the same course.
11. An otherwise eligible candidate who did not appear in the first counselling is allowed to appear in the second or subsequent counselling and will be offered the available course/seat as per his/her rank/merit in that counselling.
12. The second counselling will be conducted for vacant seats, if any.
13. In case of any seat(s) remaining unfilled in any reserved category due to non-availability of an eligible candidate(s), the same will be de-reserved and filled from amongst general category candidates as per merit/rank in NEET (UG) - **2026**.
14. No separate counselling letter will be issued.
15. No TA/DA will be paid for attending counselling.
16. Eligible candidates should report at the following venue by 9.30 AM for marking their attendance and scrutiny of the original documents:

19. Candidates, after scrutiny of original documents, will be escorted to the venue of the counselling.

ADMISSION

1. The selected candidates have to undergo medical examination by the constituted Medical Board on the same day or succeeding day of their admission to the course. Only those candidates who are found to be medically fit shall be granted admission.
2. The candidates, who do not appear before the Medical Board or are found medically unfit, shall not be allowed to join the course.
3. Admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with the rules/criteria mentioned in this prospectus. However, in all matters which need interpretation or for which no provision exists in the prospectus, the decision of the Admission Committee shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained regarding rejection or disqualification of any candidate.
4. Fees are to be paid on the day of the medical examination if the candidate is found to be medically fit. The candidature of the eligible candidates, who do not deposit the prescribed fees in full, shall stand automatically cancelled and vacancies so caused shall be offered to the candidates next in order of merit. No correspondence or appeal in this connection will be entertained by the Admission Committee.
5. In case the information furnished or certificates/documents submitted by the candidate are found to be fake or the candidate is found to have withheld or concealed information in the print out online application form, his/her admission shall stand cancelled and the fee deposited shall be forfeited. In addition, he/she may also face legal action under the law of the land.
6. **The original certificates of the selected candidates will be retained by the respective institution as per the instructions issued by the Director General Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide letter No.F. No. U 12021/33/2209-MEC (Pt. II) dated 03.02.2010.**
7. **The original certificates of the selected candidates shall be returned only if the seat is surrendered in writing by the candidate, as per the instructions issued by the Director General Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide letter No. F. No. U 12021/33/2209-MEC (Pt. II) dated 03.02.2010.**
8. All admissions to MBBS/ BDS/ BHMS courses shall be provisional and subject to the approval by Panjab University, National Medical Commission /Dental Council of India/Professional regulatory bodies of the concerned courses.
9. All legal disputes relating to admission of students will be subject to courts having jurisdiction in Chandigarh.

Important:

- a) **Any directions/orders governing admissions to any of the courses from the Government/Hon'ble Courts/Regulatory bodies will be binding on all candidates.**
- b) **The Rules and Regulations, including fee to be charged, are subject to revision and amendment from time to time and the revised decision will be applicable irrespective of those given in this prospectus.**

Since the BDS Course is conducted by Dr. Harvansh Singh Judge Dental College, a constituent college of Panjab University, Chandigarh, the criteria for admission to the same shall be governed by the rules and regulations laid down by the Panjab University, Chandigarh, for the saidcourse. The criteria for admission to BDS course cannot be extrapolated for admission to MBBS or other course and vice versa.

A-3): Eligibility Criteria, General Condition and admission procedure for 156 UT Chandigarh Pool seats: (General, General PwBD, SC, SC PwBD, OBC (NCL), OBC (NCL-PwBD), OCI)

In supersession of the Notification No. GMCH/TA-1(4/E)/2018/45819-27 dated 31.10.2018 and all other notifications/ instructions/ orders issued in this regard, the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is pleased to amend the eligibility criteria for admission to State (UT Chandigarh) Quota Seats in MBBS course in Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector-32, Chandigarh.

The following criteria shall be followed for admission to State (UT Chandigarh) Quota Seats in MBBS Course in GMCH-32, Chandigarh from the date of issuance of this notification vide No. 4486/E-134842/F-II(GMCH)/2023/10399 dated 15.07.2022: -

1. Candidates, who had completed 10th, 10+1 and 10+2 from schools/ colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, as regular student of the said school/college.

OR

2. Candidates, whose parents are residents of Chandigarh for the past 05 years immediately preceding the date of application, even if they do not satisfy the criteria as laid down in condition No.1 above. The requisite residence certificate issued from the *Office of Deputy Commissioner, UT Chandigarh*, will be taken as proof for this purpose.

OR

3. Candidates, whose parents are employees of Central Government/ State Government and who are on deputation to U.T. Administration, including government employees of Chandigarh Administration/ employees working in autonomous bodies/ companies in which Chandigarh Administration has 20% or more share, for the past 03 years immediately preceding the date of application, even if they do not satisfy the criteria as laid down in condition No. 1 & 2 above.

OR

4. Those candidates who are wards of serving Defence Personnel/ Ex- Servicemen, having permanent address of UT Chandigarh in their service record, at the time of entry into defence services. The requisite certificate for permanent address issued by the respective Competent Authority will be taken as proof for this purpose.

OR

5. As per judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (C) No. 891 of 2021, Dated 03.02.2023, candidates who have secured OCI Card before 04.03.2021 will be eligible for General seats of UT Chandigarh Pool subject to fulfillment of one of the above-mentioned clauses from A3.1 to A3.3.
6. ***Candidates of all the five categories mentioned above will have to submit an undertaking/ affidavit that the candidate has not opted and claimed benefit of residence in any other State/UT other than Chandigarh after the declaration of NEET result.***
7. ***Candidates who fall into any of the below mentioned categories (a-d) will be considered as "opted and claimed benefit of residence in any other state/UT other than Chandigarh":***
 - a. If a candidate has applied for State Quota seats claiming residence in any other state(s) / UT(s) other than UT Chandigarh; his/her candidature will be rejected.
 - b. If a candidate has applied for State Quota/ Management Quota seats in Pvt. College/ Deemed Universities claiming residence in state(s)/ UT(s) other than UT Chandigarh; his/her candidature will be rejected.
 - c. If a candidate has applied in GMCH as well as in other states and has withdrawn his/ her candidature from other states; his/ her candidature will be cancelled and will be treated as 'opted and claimed' in other states even if he/ she withdraws the application after applying.
 - d. If the clarification sought from the candidate by any means, viz, email, phone, text message, written letter etc. is not received within stipulated period, the candidature will be cancelled.

Candidates need to submit one of the following documents/certificates to establish their eligibility for UT Chandigarh Pool:-

- i. Candidates, who had completed 10th, 10+1 and 10+2 from schools/ colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, as regular student of the said school/college **as per Appendix A1** if eligible as per criteria 1.

OR

- ii. Residence Certificate to be issued by the office of the Deputy Commissioner, U.T., Chandigarh, mentioning period of residence with dates **as per Appendix A2** if eligible as per criteria 2.

OR

- iii. Certificate to be issued by the respective Head of the Department for candidates whose parents are working in Central Government/ State Government and are on deputation to Chandigarh Administration/ employees of Chandigarh Administration / working in Autonomous bodies/ companies in which Chandigarh Administration has 20% or more share for the past 03 years immediately preceding the date of application **as per Appendix A3**, if eligible as per criteria 3.

OR

- iv. Certificate to be issued by the respective Competent Authority in case of candidates applying in the category of wards of serving Defence Personnel/ Ex-Servicemen **as per Appendix A4** if eligible as per criteria 4.

AND

- v. Candidates of all five categories A3.1 to A3.5 above, will have to **submit an undertaking/ affidavit that he/ she has not opted and claimed benefit of residence in any other State/ UT other than Chandigarh after the declaration of NEET result, both at the time of applying and again a fresh undertaking at the time of appearing for counselling [as per Appendix A5]**

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Only INDIAN CITIZENS are eligible to apply under the categories of UT Chandigarh Pool.
2. As per judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (C) No. 891 of 2021, Dated 03.02.2023, **Candidates, who have secured OCI Card before 04.03.2021 will be eligible for General seats of UT Chandigarh Pool, as per their rank and merit in the combined merit list, subject to fulfillment of the eligibility condition for UT Chandigarh Pool as mentioned at A-3.5.**
 - They also have to fulfill A-3.6 and other conditions applicable to UT Chandigarh Pool candidates.
 - Only those candidates who have claimed their status as OCI card holder while appearing for NEET (UG)-2026 will be eligible to be considered for UT Chandigarh Pool, subject to fulfillment of the eligibility condition applicable to UT Chandigarh Pool category.
 - In addition, they will be eligible for seats reserved for Indian Foreign Students, if they have opted, subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions applicable for these seats.
 - If selected against General category seats of UT Chandigarh Pool, they will be charged fee as applicable to other UT Chandigarh Pool General Category candidates. However, if selected against seats reserved for Indian Foreign Students, they will be charged fee applicable to Indian Foreign Students category.
3. Only those candidates whose names appear in the NEET (UG) - **2026** list of successful candidates, prepared by NTA (National Testing Agency), will be eligible for admission in MBBS course.
4. The candidates must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology and English as a regular student of school/college recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the union territory of Chandigarh individually in the qualifying 12th standard examination.

5. A candidate must have secured the following minimum percentage of marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together in 12th standard examination:

General category: (Including Foreign Indian Students/OCI Card Holder)	not less than 50%
Persons with Benchmark Disability (General Category) (Including Foreign Indian Students/OCI Card Holder)	not less than 45%
SC/OBC(NCL) category: (including SC(PwBD)/OBC(NCL) PwBD.	not less than 40%
6. The Candidates must have been included in the rank list prepared on the basis of NEET (UG)-2026 by securing the following minimum percentile in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Biotechnology taken together:

General category: (Including Foreign Indian Students/OCI Card Holder)	not less than 50 th Percentile
Persons with Benchmark Disability (General Category) (Including Foreign Indian Students/OCI Card Holder)	not less than 45 th Percentile
SC/OBC(NCL) category: (including SC(PwBD)/OBC(NCL) PwBD	not less than 40 th Percentile
7. Admission will be made strictly on the basis of rank obtained in NEET (UG) - **2026**.
8. The Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes Category shall submit a certificate to this effect issued by the Tehsildar/Magistrate 1st Class/Deputy Commissioner, UT Chandigarh, bearing the seal & signature of the issuing authority. **(Specimen copy of the certificate is appended as Appendix C).**
9. The Candidates belonging to Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL) Category shall submit a certificate to this effect issued by the Tehsildar/Magistrate 1st Class/Deputy Commissioner, UT Chandigarh, bearing the seal & signature of the issuing authority. **(Specimen copy of the certificate is appended as Appendix C-I).**
10. Total No. of seats reserved for the PwBD category is 08. Counselling for the PwBD category shall be conducted first. Candidate(s) selected against the quota for PwBD shall be placed in the appropriate category to which they belong. Accordingly, SC PwBD candidates shall be allotted seats from the SC category, OBC (NCL) PwBD candidates from the OBC (NCL) and General PwBD candidates from the General category. The corresponding number of seats shall be deducted from the respective category.

11. After allotting seats to the PwBD candidates, rest of the seats in SC category, OBC (NCL) Category and General category will be filled as per the merit obtained in the NEET UG 2026.
12. In the Second Counselling, first of all, the counselling for the SC Category seats will be done, followed by the OBC (NCL) and then General Category.
13. Any seat(s) remaining unfilled from UT Chandigarh Pool SC, OBC (NCL) category on account of non-availability of eligible candidates shall be added to the UT Chandigarh Pool General Category in the Second counselling itself.
14. The original certificates of the selected candidates will be retained by the college as per the instructions issued by the Director General Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide letter No. F. No. U 12021/33/2209-MEC (Pt. II) dated 03.02.2010.
15. The original certificates of the selected candidates shall be returned only if the seat is surrendered in writing by the candidate, as per the instructions issued by the Director General Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi vide letter No. F. No. U 12021/33/2209-MEC (Pt. II) dated 03.02.2010.
16. All relevant clauses of Counselling and Admission (Page No. 11-15) will be applicable to the candidates appearing for/admitted against UT Chandigarh Pool seats.

A-4): Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats reserved for Scheduled Castes including SC PwBD candidates

1. The candidates must fulfill relevant Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats.
2. Candidates must have claimed his/ her eligibility for SC/ SC (PwBD) category while applying for NEET (UG) - **2026** examination.
3. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes Category shall submit a certificate to this effect issued by the Tehsildar/Magistrate 1st Class/Deputy Commissioner, UT Chandigarh, bearing the seal & signature of the issuing authority. **(Specimen copy of the certificate is appended as Appendix C)**

Important:

Certificate, not bearing the seal of the competent authority, will not be accepted.

Scheduled Caste Category candidates who otherwise fulfill the eligibility criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool, ***but submit Scheduled Caste category certificate issued by Sate/ UT other than UT Chandigarh***, will not be considered eligible for admission against seats reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates in UT Chandigarh Pool. Such candidates will be considered for General Category of UT Chandigarh Pool only.

4. Any seat(s) remaining unfilled from UT Chandigarh Pool SC Category on account of non-availability of eligible candidates shall be added to UT Chandigarh Pool General Category, and filled from combined merit list as per merit/rank in NEET (UG) - **2026**, as per reservation policy of Chandigarh Administration applicable to Medical institutions in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, notified vide letter No. 19/1/3/93/IH(3)/11138, Dated: 07.06.1995.

A-5): Eligibility criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats reserved for candidates Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD).

1. 5% seats of UT Chandigarh Pool are reserved for PwBD candidates on Horizontal basis.
2. Horizontal reservation cuts across vertical reservation (in what is called inter locking reservation) and candidate selected against the quota for PwBDs have to be placed in the appropriate category viz. SC or General depending upon the category to which they belong. ***Candidates applying for admission under the quota reserved for PwBD must select whether they belong to SC or General category while filling the application form.***
3. **Candidates must have claimed their eligibility for PwBD category while applying for NEET (UG) – 2026 examination.**
4. The candidates must fulfill relevant Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats.
5. Seats mentioned against Scheduled Caste Category and General Category includes seats reserved for PwBD Candidates. PwBD Candidates will be placed in the category to which they belong and corresponding number of seats will be deducted from the seats mentioned against the respective category i.e. either Scheduled Caste or General Category.
6. “Own merit” General (PwBD) and SC (PwBD) candidates will be eligible for selection against General category seats according to their rank and merit in the Combined Merit List.
7. Only the Disability Certificate issued by designated centers approved by National Medical Commission will be accepted. List of centers approved for issuing of disability certificates is attached at **Appendix D.**
8. Admission will be made strictly on the basis of rank obtained in NEET (UG) - **2026** for PwBD category.
9. Every candidate shall submit a self-certified affidavit declaring his or her functional abilities in the format specified in Schedule-I, which shall be verified by the Medical Assessment Board during the course of assessment - Copies of Schedule I are also attached.

A-6): Eligibility criteria and admission procedure for Foreign Indian Student:

1. The Candidates must be of Indian origin. These seats are not open to Foreign Nationals who are not of Indian Origin.
2. Candidates must have claimed his/her eligibility for NRI/OCI category, as the case may be while applying for NEET (UG) - **2026** examination. However, for Indian Citizens, who are claiming a seat under this quota AND who have resided in a country other than India for a minimum period of three years immediately preceding the year of admission (2026), the candidate who have applied in general / specific reserved category will also be considered.
3. The candidates meeting any of the following criteria will be eligible to apply for admission under this category:
 - a. Persons of Indian origin who are citizens of countries other than India and hold the passport of the country concerned.
 - b. Overseas Citizens of India.
 - c. Indian citizens (candidates) who have resided in a country other than India for a minimum period of three years immediately preceding the year of admission in the Govt. Medical College and Hospital, Sector-32, Chandigarh.

Explanation:

The aforesaid condition of residence for a minimum period of three years in a country other than India prescribed in clause (iii) above means ***actual/physical residence on a regular basis***. Notional, Deemed or constructive residence of any kind shall not be considered for this purpose. Accordingly, ***possession of a Green card/Permanent Resident Permit or Card will, ipso facto, not confer eligibility or entitlement for admission***. For compliance with this clause, the candidate should submit the certificates from the school(s) attended in a country other than India during the three years immediately preceding the year of admission as a regular student (Class 12 in 2026-2027 Session). **If there is a gap period in the studies between the completion of 10+2 and year of application then the candidate must provide proof of actual residence abroad for three years immediately preceding the year of admission, in the form of a certificate issued from the Indian embassy/Consulate in that country that the candidate was residing in the concerned country (Foreign country) covering an actual period of 3 years. This applies to those students who have completed Class 12 in the Session 2026 or earlier**

- i. The expression "Overseas Citizens of India" in clauses (ii) above refers to persons registered as such under Section 7-A of the Citizenship Act, 1955 as amended up-to-date.
- ii. Here it is important to mention that OCI card holders after 4.3.2021 (as per point no.5 of eligibility criteria at Page No.17 and Point No.2 of General conditions and Admission Procedure at Page No.19) shall not be eligible for admission to seats reserved exclusively for Indian Citizens.
4. Only NEET (UG) - **2026** qualified candidates can apply for admission against Foreign Indian Student category seats for admission year 2026.
5. The candidates must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio- technology & English individually in the qualifying examination (equivalent to 12th standard) securing minimum percentage of 50% marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology.

Important Note: The candidates who have studied from the Foreign/International Board should ensure that the qualifying examination passed by them are, in scope and standard, as explained in CODE: 07 of the "Information Bulletin for National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (UG)- 2026 i.e. as under:

Code 07: Any other examination which in scope and standard (Last 02 years of 10+2 Study comprising of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology; which shall include practical test in these subjects) is found to be equivalent to the Intermediate Science Examination of an Indian University/Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology including practical tests in each of these subjects and English.

Provided further that the students who have received education abroad and wish to seek admission into medical colleges in India must have passed in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology and English with 50% marks in Class 12 (Foreign / International Board) and their equivalency determined by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as per regulations of the National Medical Commission AND the concerned University [i.e. Panjab University, Chandigarh].

6. The candidate must provide the certificate of 10+2/pre-medical/of 10+2+3 system qualifying examination from any university/board showing detailed marks/explanation sheets of grade. The candidates must provide the percentage marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology as well as English of both Class 10+1 and 10+2 level.
7. Foreign Indian Student candidates who have passed 10+2 from CBSE/PSEB/HPSE/HSEB or any other Board/University of India, need not obtain eligibility and equivalence certificate from AIU or the Panjab University, Chandigarh.

8. Admission to Foreign Indian Student category seats will be conducted in accordance with the instructions/guidelines issued by the Chandigarh Administration from time to time. These candidates will be divided into two categories which are as follows:

Category-I: This category includes **Foreign Indian Student** candidates who have ancestral background of Chandigarh. To be eligible for this category candidate should fulfill one of the following criteria:

- I. Grandparents/ parents/ self should have been a resident of Chandigarh for a minimum period of 5 years at any time since the origin of Chandigarh.
- II. Own/ owned immovable property in the name of grandparents/ parents/ self in Chandigarh for at least 5 years at any time since the origin of Chandigarh.

A certificate to the effect of either of the above mentioned criteria is required from the office of the Deputy Commissioner, U.T., Chandigarh.

Category-II: This category includes Foreign Indian Student candidates who have ancestral background of States/UTs other than UT Chandigarh.

A certificate to this effect from competent Government authority i.e. office of the Deputy Commissioner from the district of that State or Union Territory or OCI Card has to be submitted. In case of Indian Citizens, the Indian Passport may also be considered as proof of ancestral background of other Indian State **Any other proof of ancestral background will NOT be accepted.**

9. First preference will be given to Category-I candidates.
10. If sufficient number of candidates under Category-I are eligible and available, then they will be admitted first even if candidates under Category-II are higher in merit.
11. In case a seat under the Foreign Indian Student category remains vacant, the same shall be added to UT Chandigarh Pool General category and filled from combined merit list as per merit/rank in NEET (UG) - **2026**.
12. All relevant clauses of **Counselling** and **Admission (Page No.11-15)** will be applicable to **Foreign Indian Student** category candidates.

A-7): Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats reserved for Other Backward Class (OBC (NCL) including OBC (NCL) PwBD candidates.

1. The candidates must fulfill relevant Eligibility Criteria for UT Chandigarh Pool seats.
2. Candidates must have claimed his/ her eligibility for OBC (NCL)/ OBC (NCL) (PwBD) category while applying for NEET (UG) - **2026** examination.

3. **Candidates belonging to Other Backward Class (OBC (NCL) shall submit a certificate to this effect issued by the Tehsildar/Magistrate 1st Class/Deputy Commissioner, UT Chandigarh, bearing the seal & signature of the issuing authority. (Specimen copy of the certificate is appended as Appendix C-1).**

Important:

Certificates not bearing the seal of the competent authority shall not be accepted. Candidates belonging to Other Backward Class (OBC (NCL) candidates who otherwise fulfill the eligibility criteria for the UT Chandigarh Pool, **but submit an Other Backward Class (OBC (NCL) category certificate issued by State/ UT other than UT Chandigarh**, shall not be considered eligible for admission against seats reserved for **Other Backward Class (OBC (NCL)** category in UT Chandigarh Pool. Such candidates shall be considered only under the General Category of UT Chandigarh Pool.

4. Any seat(s) remaining unfilled from UT Chandigarh Pool **Other Backward Class (OBC (NCL)** on account of non-availability of eligible candidates shall be added to UT Chandigarh Pool General Category, and filled from combined merit list as per merit/rank in NEET (UG) - **2026**, as per reservation policy of Chandigarh Administration applicable to Medical institutions in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, notified vide letter No. SWD/RA/OBC-Act/2025/6692 Dated 07.08.2025.

A-8): Eligibility criteria and admission procedure for Central Pool seats:

1. **These seats for MBBS Course will be filled up on the basis of recommendations of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, New Delhi.**
2. Eligible candidates should **NOT** apply directly for these seats to Government Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh.
3. The candidates must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology & English individually in the qualifying 12th standard examination.
4. A candidate must have secured following minimum percentage of marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together in 12th standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination:

General category:

(Including NRI/Foreign Indian Students/OCI card holder) not less than 50%

Person with Benchmark Disability (General Category): not less than 45%

SC/OBC (NCL) category:

(Including SC PwBD, OBC (NCL) PwBD Category) not less than 40%

5. The candidates nominated by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, who have not passed their 12th standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination from Indian University/Board will have to obtain the eligibility and Equivalence certificates for the qualifying examination (equivalent to 10+2 examinations of PSEB/CBSE/ICSE) from Panjab University, Chandigarh AND NMC designated authority (AIU or other).
6. The candidate must have secured following minimum marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology taken together in the NEET (UG) - **2026** examination:
 General category:
 (Including NRI/Foreign Indian Students/OCI card holder) not less than 50th Percentile
 Person with Benchmark Disability (General Category): not less than 45th Percentile
 SC/OBC (NCL) category:
 (Including SC PwBD, OBC (NCL) PwBD category) not less than 40th Percentile
7. All relevant clauses of Admission (**Page 16 to 19**) will be applicable to candidates recommended for admission/admitted against Central Pool seat.
8. Any seat(s) remaining unfilled from Central Pool quota, if reverted, shall be added to UT Chandigarh Pool General Category and filled from combined merit list as per merit/rank in NEET (UG) - **2026**.

A-9): Eligibility criteria and admission procedure for 15% All India Quota seats:

1. **Counselling:** These seats will be allocated through online counselling conducted by the Directorate General of Health Services, Government of India. Information for online counselling would also be available on DGHS website. Any query related to Counselling may be referred to the following address:

2. The candidates also have to fulfill all relevant eligibility criteria as laid down in the Information Bulletin, NEET (UG) Entrance Examination 2026 issued by NTA (National Testing Agency).
3. All relevant clauses of Admission (**Page 16 to 19**) will also be applicable to candidates recommended for admission/admitted against All India Quota seats.
4. Any seat(s) if reverted back from All India Quota shall be added to UT Chandigarh Pool General Category and filled from combined merit list as per merit/rank in NEET (UG) - **2026**.

2. The payment by Foreign Indian Student candidates will be accepted through bank draft in favour of **Director Principal (Academics)**, Govt. Medical College Hospital, Chandigarh. Conversion charges will be borne by the candidate only. The payment can also be made **in Indian Rupees equivalent to US \$ 1,10,000 (Admission Fee) + US \$1210 (Registration Charges)** from an NRE account only and certificate to this effect should be issued by the concerned bank.
3. If Foreign Indian Student candidate opts to pay admission fee in installments instead of paying in lump sum, then he/she will have to give a bank guarantee for the balance fee at the time of admission with its validity as mentioned below: -
 US \$ 60000 + US \$1210 registration charges at the time of admission.
 US \$ 25000 (payable at the start of 2nd year), bank guarantee valid upto December 2027*.
 US \$ 25000 (payable at the start of 3rd year), bank guarantee valid upto December 2028.

4. In case of surrender of seat, the fees and other funds deposited at the time of admission will be refunded after deduction of Rs. 1000/- (in case of General / SC/ PwBD/OBC (NCL) and US\$1210 or equivalent in Indian Rupee for Foreign Indian Student of total amount paid at the time of admission if vacated seat gets filled up. If the seat so vacated is not filled up, the entire course fee & funds for admission shall stand forfeited **and only the security fee will be refunded after the written request by the student.**

A-11): All admissions to MBBS course shall be provisional and subject to the approval by Panjab University, Chandigarh and National Medical Commission, New Delhi.

Note:

Since the BDS Course is conducted by Dr. Harvansh Singh Judge Dental College a constituent college of Panjab University, Chandigarh, the criteria for admission to the same shall be governed by the rules and regulations laid down by the Panjab University, Chandigarh for the said course. The criteria for admission to BDS course cannot be extrapolated for admission to MBBS or other course and vice versa.

1. There is no UT pool for admission to BDS course. All seats are open to candidates from all over India.
2. Five (05) seats have been allocated to Central Pool for candidates belonging to States with no Medical/Dental college and Ministries nominated candidates. The admission to these seats shall be made by Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

B-3): General Eligibility Criteria (All India Pool)

1. Every candidate seeking admission to BDS should have attained the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2026.
2. Only candidates whose names appear in the NEET (UG)-2026 merit list of successful candidates prepared by NTA (National Testing Agency) for BDS will be eligible to apply. This condition is also applicable to International/Foreign Nationals/ NRI Category candidates.
3. A candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Bio-technology & English individually in the qualifying 12th standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination. This condition is also applicable to International/Foreign Nationals/ NRI Category candidates.
4. A candidate must have secured following minimum percentage of marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together in 12th standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination:

General category: not less than 50%
(Including candidates from Hoshiarpur District,
preferably of Jaj (Judge Community)/ NRI/Foreign National

SC/ST/ Backward Class (BC) category: not less than 40%

Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD): ***In respect of candidates with locomotor disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70%, the minimum of 45% marks for Gen-PwBD and 40% marks for SC-PwBD are required).***

<u>Important Note:-</u> Candidates passing 12th Standard examination from recognized board by Central/ State Government only, are eligible for admission.
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5. A candidate appearing/appeared in the qualifying 12th Standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination in 2026 where result is awaited can also apply. However he/she shall not be eligible for admission, if he/she does not pass the qualifying examination with the required pass percentage of marks prior to the first round of Counselling. He/she will be allowed to attend first counselling, only if detailed marks certificate of the above said examination is submitted prior to or at the time of first counselling, failing which he/she will be declared ineligible for admission in academic session starting in year 2026 and his/her application will be rejected.

6. The candidates must have secured following minimum marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Bio-technology taken together in the NEET (UG)-2026 for BDS

General category: not less than 50th percentile
(Including candidates from Hoshiarpur District,
preferably of Jaj (Judge Community)/ NRI/Foreign National

SC/ST/ Backward Class (BC) category: not less than 40th percentile

Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD): ***In respect of candidates with locomotor disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70%, the minimum of 45th percentile for Gen-PwBD and 40th percentile for SC-PwBD are required).***

7. All eligible candidates including own merit candidates (as per merit criteria for General Category) from reserved categories, will be considered for admission against general category seats according to their rank/merit in the combined list, in addition to the category/categories they have applied for.
8. Candidate(s) belonging to a reserved category who fulfills all the criteria for general category (own merit candidates) and on the basis of his/her rank/merit in the **NEET (UG)-2026** obtains admission in general category shall not be counted towards the seats earmarked for the reserved category concerned.
9. Original certificates/documents will have to be deposited by the candidate at the time of counseling, after the seat has been allotted to the candidate. The certificates/documents shall be returned to the candidate only after surrendering the seat.
10. In case any candidate surrenders a seat, he/she will not be eligible to attend subsequent counselling for the BDS course.

B-4): Eligibility Criteria for Foreign National/ NRI Students

Only NEET (UG)-2026 qualified (not less than 50th percentile) candidates can apply for admission against NRI Category seats for admission year 2026.

A foreign national may seek admission in BDS being offered by the University through Office of the Dean International Students, Panjab University, Chandigarh as per the guidelines/ terms & Conditions available at the website of <https://www.dis.puchd.ac.in/> provided that such candidates should be NEET (UG)-2026 qualified.

Notwithstanding any conditions laid down at <https://www.dis.puchd.ac.in> if the candidates are not NEET (UG)-2026 qualified he or she will not consider for admission in BDS course under Foreign National/ NRI category under any circumstances.

IMPORTANT

- ✓ As per new guidelines issued by Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, it is mandatory for all foreign students to first register on Study in India (SII) website & generates a Unique SII ID to initiate admission process.
- ✓ This SII ID will be the main tracking ID for foreign students for their complete student journey.
- ✓ Students will be granted Student visa and E-student Visa, only if they have unique SII ID.
- ✓ If a student has paid fees to the institute and the institute has updated the same on SII website, then the foreign student is eligible for E-student Visa as well.
- ✓ The Institute's confirmation of the student's fee payment supports the visa verification process, without which student might not be granted the visa.
- ✓ MHA can verify the foreign student's details via their SII ID by logging into their BOI Module on SII website.

- **Foreign National students** with nomination/sponsorship by any Foreign State, Embassy or Authority in India/Ministry of Govt. of India under a Study in India/Exchange Programme, etc. may apply for admission to Panjab University through ICCR website subject to the condition that the student is eligible to seek admission as per the regulations of the course.

The definition of the terms, "International/Foreign National, Non-resident Indians (NRI)/ and Wards of NRI/Foreign National" be considered as under:-

(1) International/Foreign Nationals (FN):

As per UGC guidelines circulated vide its letter D.O.No.F.1/2022 (CPP-II) dated 30th September, 2022, International/Foreign National students in this context shall be defined as the one who shall possess a foreign passport.

(2) Non-resident Indians (NRI):

A person shall be deemed to be Non-resident Indian for seeking admission in Panjab University if she/he fulfils the criterion (as amended from time to time) for status of NRI under Income Tax Act, 1961, in the year in which he/she seeks admission in Panjab University.

As per Income Tax Act, 1961 the present criterion for determination of status NRI is as follows:

'Non-resident Indian' is an individual who is a citizen of India or a person of Indian origin and who is not a resident of India. Thus, in order to determine whether an Individual is a non-resident Indian or not, his residential status is required to be determined under Section 6. As per Section 6 of the Income-tax Act, an individual is said to be non-resident in India if he is not a resident in India and an individual is deemed to be resident in India in any previous year if he satisfies any of the following conditions: -

- (i) If he is in India for a period of 182 days or more during the previous year;
OR
- (ii) If he is in India for a period of 60 days or more during the previous year and 365 days or more during 4 years immediately preceding the previous year.

However, condition No. (ii) does not apply where an individual being citizen of India or a person of Indian origin, who being outside India, comes on a visit to India during the previous year.

OR

- A person shall be deemed to be of Indian origin if he, or either of his parents or any of his parents or any of his grand-parents, was born in undivided India.

OR

- Indian Nationals who have completed their last qualifying programme outside India.

OR

- Indian Nationals who have acquired NRI status and holding it for the last three years after obtaining an undergraduate degree from India.

OR

- A person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:

- (i) For or on taking up employment outside India; or
- (ii) For carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
- (iii) For any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

(3) Ward of NRI/FN

A student who seeks admission as a ward of Foreign National or Non Resident Indian should be in a first degree/blood relationship with foreign national/OCI/PIO or Non-resident Indian. The term first degree /blood relationship includes:

Spouse/Father or mother of the Candidate/Siblings/Paternal or maternal Grandparents

GENERAL RULES FOR NRI/FOREIGN NATIONAL STUDENTS

1. A student admitted under NRI/Wards of FN/NRI quota may change his/her admission to a vacant seat in General /Reserved Category provided the student qualifies the Entrance Test **(if prescribed for the respective course)** and the merit of the student falls within the list of students admitted in General/Reserve Category.
2. Student once admitted under NRI/FN category to undergraduate course shall be covered under the definition of NRI/FN for subsequent admission to any course at Panjab University.

NRI/FN students shall also have to comply with any other requirements prescribed by the Govt. of India and Panjab University from time to time.

3. Order of preference to determine merit for admission against NRI seats in departments/Centres/Institutions where NRI seats are reserved out of total sanctioned strength.

a) Foreign National

b) NRI

c) Ward of NRI/FN

ELIGIBILITY AND ADMISSION CRITERION

- (i)** The students who will be admitted against the NRI quota should have the basic qualification fixed by the National Dental Commission (erstwhile Dental Council of India) for admission in Dental courses.
- (ii)** A candidate once admitted as NRI candidate in an undergraduate course shall be covered under the definition of NRI for subsequent admission to any course.
- (iii)** The NRI/Foreign Nationals students wishing to join any of the University Teaching Departments of Panjab University for the first time are required to obtain an eligibility/equivalency certificate from the Deputy Registrar (General), Panjab University, Chandigarh or Academic certificates of passing the qualifying or equivalent examination approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/Common wealth Universities/International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/Certificates.

- (iv) After obtaining the Eligibility Certificate, the candidates must submit alongwith online application to BDS course.

CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

The NRI/Foreign Nationals students shall provide the following certificates/documents (whichever is applicable):

- 1) Eligibility/equivalency certificate from the Deputy Registrar (General), Panjab University, Chandigarh or Academic certificates of passing the qualifying or equivalent examination approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/Common wealth Universities/International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/Certificates.
- 2) Copy of Passport/Relevant Documents to claim NRI/Foreign National Seat.
- 3) Relevant Documents to be submitted by Wards of NRI
 - a. Proof of relationship of student with Guardian
 - b. Affidavits from the Guardian
 - c. Affidavits from the student
 - d. Undertaking from the Guardian
 - e. Employment proof of the guardian
 - f. Copy of the PR Card/Citizenship proof/ Passport of the guardian (from the country he/she resides)
 - g. All documents as applicable for eligible candidates of General category.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED AFTER CONFORMATION OF ADMISSION

- 1) The Foreign National students admitted are required to fill up Foreign Student Information System (FSIS) Form complete in all respects, along with copies of passport and Visa and submit to the office of Dean International Students, Panjab University, Chandigarh. This form is an urgent requirement of the Foreign Registration Office (FRO), Sector-9, Chandigarh and the student has to report to the Foreign Registration Office (FRO) within fourteen days of arrival in Chandigarh, with the number generated after the online submission of this form.(<https://indianfro.gov.in/eservices/home.jsp>)
- 2) Foreign Students Information System (FSIS) is to be submitted by hand by the student and the FSIS No. will be issued by the office of the Dean International Students Office personally to the students.

- 3) **Each NRI/Foreign Student is required to submit “Foreign Students Welfare Fee” of Rs.8,700/- for five year @ Rs. 1740/- (approx.) per annum**, which may be deposited with the ‘Extension Counter, State Bank of India, Administrative Block, Panjab University, Chandigarh **(Fee Code: M0140)**. Original Receipts of the fee deposited is to be submitted to the office of the Dean International Students along with Registration Form (To be submitted after Confirmation of Admission).

B-5): Inter-Changeability and Transfer of Seats during Second Counselling.

1. In the SC/ST reserved category the seats shall be regarded as ‘interchangeable’. That is to say, if a sufficient number of eligible candidates are not available to fill up the seats reserved for Scheduled Tribes, seats may be filled up from among the eligible candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, and vice-versa.
2. Seat remaining unfilled from SC (PwBD) category on account of non-availability of eligible candidate shall be filled from eligible SC Category candidates.
3. In case sufficient number of eligible candidates, belonging to reserved categories (SC/ST/BC/Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD General Category), Hoshiarpur District, preferably Jaj (Judge) community / International / NRI Students /Central Pool) are not available, the vacant seats shall be transferred to General Category of All India Pool.

B-6) Medical Examination :-

1. All admitted candidates will have to undergo medical examination (fee of ₹1000/- in cash) by the Medical Board of the Dr. Harvansh Singh Judge Institute of Dental Sciences & Hospital, Panjab University, Sector 25, Chandigarh. The admission of those candidates who do not appear before Medical Board or are found to be medically unfit is liable to be cancelled.

B-7) All admissions to the BDS course shall be provisional subject to approval by the Panjab University/ National Dental Commission (erstwhile Dental Council of India)

- b) The students partly defaulter of fee in excess of as prescribed in the respective category (if applicable) shall be required to clear their dues by the date as prescribed by Panjab University which will be displayed on the notice board of the institute, failing which their Roll Nos. for the university exam shall not be delivered to the students.

B-9): Rules for Refund of Tuition Fee

- I. If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he/she enrolled, the Institution concerned shall following five-tire system for there fund of fees remitted by the student.

1. In case of (1) in the above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of ₹5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

2. Fee shall be refunded by all HEIs to an eligible student within fifteen days from the date of receiving a written application from him/her in this regard.
3. Refund forms will be available at the P.U. Website i.e. <http://forms.puchd.ac.in> **(the photocopy of bank passbook of the candidate only be attached)**
4. But in all other Cases of the students continuing their studies, the Library Security will be refunded if he/she will apply within six months from the date of leaving the Department/ Institute/ Centre/ Regional Centre after completing the full course of studies.

II. Refund of Fee Rules of NRI Category and Foreign Nationals

In case, the candidate is admitted in the Foreign/NRI category and leaves the course & the seat vacated by a candidate is filled by granting admission to another applicant against the vacated seat, the tuition fee may be refunded to the person after deduction of 10% of the tuition fee as administrative charges. In case a seat vacated by such a candidate is not filled, the tuition fee may be refunded after deduction of 25% of the tuition fee as administrative charges. This will be applicable only in the case where the candidate has left the University Department/Institute/ Centre/ Regional Centre & did not join any other course in the Panjab University. All other funds and charges including Development Fund, in no case, shall be refunded. For this purpose, he/she must apply for refund on the prescribed refund application form through the Head of the Department to the Assistant Registrar Accounts-II. That the time period for applying refund of fee by the students be fixed up to 30th November. However, all other funds & charges including development fund, shall not be refunded under any circumstances, except refundable Library Security.

B-10): Cancellation of Admission

Admission of all such students who fail to attend at least 33% of the total lectures/ tutorials/ practicals etc. delivered/held in all the papers during the first ten working days from the start of teaching work shall be cancelled by the Board of Control/Joint Admission Cell after following the procedure given below:

- a) By the 12th day after the start of classes for a particular course, the names of those students who fail to attend at least 33% of the total lectures / tutorials / practicals etc. shall be put up on the Notice Board and online Notice Board of the Institute and also send a copy of the same to the office of the DUI. Within 4 days of the date of such notice, a student who is short of attendance may give in writing the reasons for his absence from the classes.

- b) If a student does not submit an application in writing within the prescribed time as stated above, or the reasons adduced by the student in his application are not found to be sufficient and justified in the opinion of the Board of Control/Joint Admission Cell, his admission shall be cancelled.
- c) All the seats thus falling vacant shall be filled strictly in the order of merit from the waiting list or through subsequent counselling before the expiry of the last date fixed for admissions by the University.
- d) When the admission of the student(s) is cancelled as stated above, the Institute shall display on the Notice Board and online Notice Board, the list of the person(s) next in the waiting list and make admissions accordingly.
- e) The cancellation of admission and permission to fill up the cancelled seat(s) shall be done in accordance with the Rules & Regulations provided in the Handbook of Information 2026.

B-11 Discharge from the BDS course:

As per National Dental Commission (erstwhile Dental Council of India (DCI) Notification No. DE-87(1)-2015 dated 27.04.2015 and passed in Senate of Panjab University vide para R-55 dated 27.09.2015:

“Any Student who does not clear the BDS course in all the subjects within a period of 9 years, including one-year Compulsory Rotatory paid Internship from the date of admission shall be discharged from the course. This is effective from the academic session i.e. 2015-16 onwards”.

Important Note:-

It is obligatory on the part of students to keep in touch with the Institute for the possibility of the seats to fall vacant.

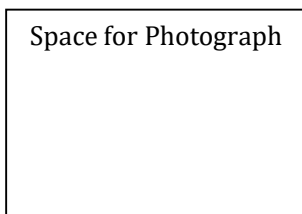
