#### **3. TENURE OF THE POST**

The above said posts are purely on contract basis and will be filled up as a stopgap arrangement initially for a period of one year or till the regular incumbent joins through UPSC, New Delhi, whichever is earlier OR till his/her services are required by the Chandigarh Administration. It is also made clear that it is an engagement for a fixed term and shall automatically cease on the expiry of the term without providing any claim to a person so engaged to any regularization of service or any consequential benefits.

#### **4. UPPER AGE LIMIT AS ON 01.01.2023:-**

The upper age limit for the above said posts on contract basis are not exceeding 50 years.

#### **5. EMOLUMENTS (On Contract Basis):**

**The emoluments to be paid on Contract Basis for the post of Assistant Professor: Initial pay Rs. 67, 700/- + NPA (wherever applicable) + Dearness Allowance (as revised for time to time).**
