3. **TENURE OF THE POST**

The above said posts are purely on contract basis and will be filled up as a stopgap arrangement initially for a period of one year or till the regular incumbent joins through UPSC, New Delhi, whichever is earlier OR till his/her services are required by the Chandigarh Administration. It is also made clear that it is an engagement for a fixed term and shall automatically cease on the expiry of the term without providing any claim to a person so engaged to any regularization of service or any consequential benefits.

4. The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of application from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, the Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi sub-division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep).

The upper age limit for the said posts is as under:-

45 years for SCs, 43 years for OBCs and 40 years for URs

- i) The candidates should fill his/her Application Form available on the GMCH website. He/she should fill up all the fields in the form. No field/column should be left blank. The ONLINE fee payment mode will be available in application form.
- ii) Candidates must note that no other mode of payment of application fees like Demand Draft, Banker Cheque, Money Order, etc. will be accepted under any circumstances. The GMCH will not be responsible for any remittance made in any form other than the method prescribed above and such applications without requisite application fee submitted through any other mode except prescribed in column ii above are likely to be rejected.
- iii) The candidates should ensure that they submit the online application alongwith payment of fee immediately, since the same is non-refundable. No representation/request/demand for refund of application fees will be entertained, if the candidate fails to apply on-line within the stipulated time after payment of application fee.

7. **Reservation and Relaxation:**

- (i) The reservation and relaxation in the upper age limit will be given only for the category of the posts reserved for such categories, as per the instructions issued by the Chandigarh Administration from time to time.
- (ii) The SC/OBC candidates applying for un-reserved posts are not entitled to any relaxation in upper age limit etc.
- (iii) The claim of the candidate to SC/OBC (not BC) categories will be considered only when accompanied by the certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format.

- (iv) Further, as per instructions issued by the Chandigarh Administration, Department of Personnel vide their letter no. 27/4/94-IH(7)-2024/2685 dated 04.09.2024, a person belonging to OBC category, he/she would be eligible for benefit of reservation of Socially and Educationally Backward Classes in UT, Chandigarh, subject to the following conditions:-

(A) General

- (i) The person and his/her parents shall actually belong to the community claimed;
- (ii) His/her community shall be included in the list of OBCs issued by the Central Govt. in respect of UT, Chandigarh or his/her community shall be included in the list of BCs issued by the Social Welfare Department, UT, Chandigarh from time to time, by notification/order(s).
- (iii) That person shall belong to Union Territory, Chandigarh.

(B) Cases of Migration

- (i) Where a person migrates from a State/UT, Chandigarh, he can claim belong to OBC/BC (and is entitled to the concession/benefit(s) only in relation to that State to which he originally belonged and not in respect of the Union Territory, Chandigarh.
- (ii) Further, when a person belonging to OBC/BC migrates from one State to UT, Chandigarh for the purpose of employment, education, etc. the prescribed authority of Chandigarh Administration may issue the OBC/BC certificate to a person who has migrated from another State/UT on the production of a genuine certificate issued to his/her father by the prescribed authority of the State/UT of his/her father's origin except where the prescribed authority feels that a detailed enquiry is necessary through the State of origin before the issue of the certificate. The certificate will be issued irrespective of whether the OBC/BC candidate in question is included in the list of OBC pertaining to UT, Chandigarh. The facility does not alter the OBC/BC status of the person in relation to the one or the other State/UT. The OBC/BC where his/her caste is not in the OBC/BC list of Chandigarh Administration, is entitled to the concessions/benefits admissible to the OBCs/BCs from the State of his/her origin and Union Government, but not from UT, Chandigarh.

OTHER GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- i) It is made clear to all the candidates that their candidature is provisional and further subject to the fulfillment eligibility criteria, age, verification of documentary proof. In case, they do not fulfill the eligibility criteria, overage, their candidature will be rejected straightway and they do not fulfill the eligibility will not be called for interview under any circumstances.
- ii) The above said posts are purely on contract basis as a stop gap arrangement initially for a period of one year or till the regular incumbent are join on the post through UPSC, New Delhi whichever is earlier.
- iii) The candidates who are willing to apply for the above said posts must have the essential qualification, experience etc. stated above, as the case may be as on **20.01.2026** i.e. last date of receipt of ONLINE applications.
- iv) The numbers of posts and reservation thereof are tentative and can be increased or decreased. The department reserves the right to reject/cancel any application or withdraw the posts at any time without assigning any reasons or without any notice whatsoever and in this regard, no application fee will be refunded.
- v) List of provisionally eligible candidates and date of interview for the said posts will be displayed on the GMCH website later on.
- vi) No separate letter for Interview will be sent.
- vii) The candidates will be called for interview based on their eligibility. However, the decision of the competent authority pertaining to their eligibility will be final and no correspondence/personal enquiries will be entertained.

- viii) Candidates are required to have a valid personal e-mail ID which should be kept active during the recruitment process, as all the information relating to recruitment of the said posts will be available only on On-Line. The candidates should ensure that the e-mail ID is not shared or mentioned to any other person. It is requested not to use any other person's e-mail ID. In case a candidate does not have a valid personal e-mail ID, he/she should create his/her new e-mail ID before applying.
- ix) The eligible candidates are required to bring all the certificates/testimonials in original, in support of their qualification, experience and date of birth etc. and also NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE from the present employer, if working in the Govt./Semi Govt./Corporate Body/Undertaking of the Central/State Govt. and in absence of which the candidate will not be allowed to appear for Interview.
